2. The manipulation of the soft tissues of the body B. Manicure
3. A succession of strokes in which the hands glide over an area with varying degrees of pressure or contact. C. Nail Oils
4. Incorporates various strokes that manipulate or press one layer of tissue over another. D. Nail Creams
5. A cosmetic treatment of the hands involving cutting, shaping, and often painting of the nails, removal of the cuticles, and softening of the skin. E. Effleurage
6. Barrier products; they contain ingredients designed to seal the surface of the skin around the nails and hold moisture in the skin. F. Nail Nipper
7. Designed to absorb into the nail plate to increase flexibility and into the surrounding skin to soften and moisturize. G. Medium Grit Abrasive
8. A colorless, inflammable liquid that has a sweetish odor used as a solvent. H. Acetone
9. (180) are used to smooth and refine surfaces. I. Lower Grit Abrasives
10. Used to remove dead cuticle tissue and to clean under the free edge. J. Paraffin
