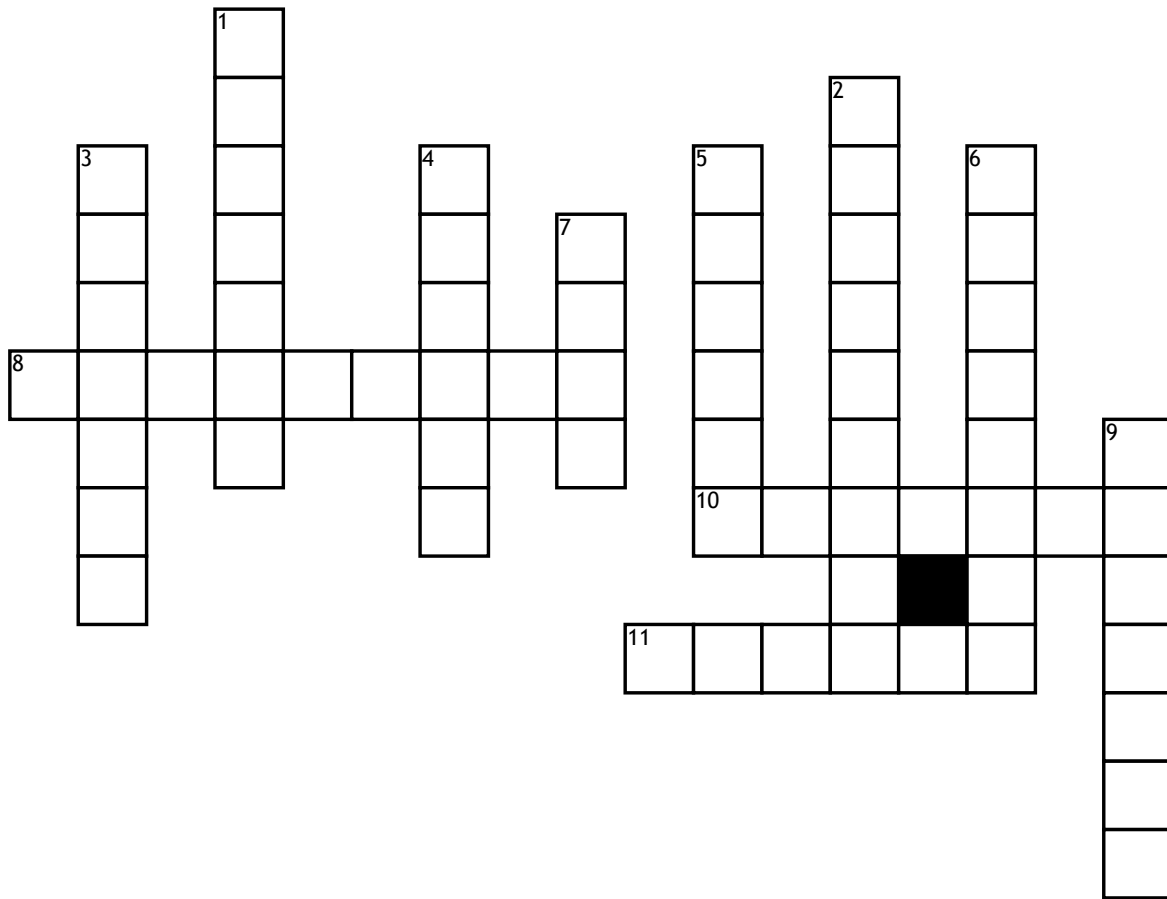


# Chapter 1 Introduction to Anatomy
