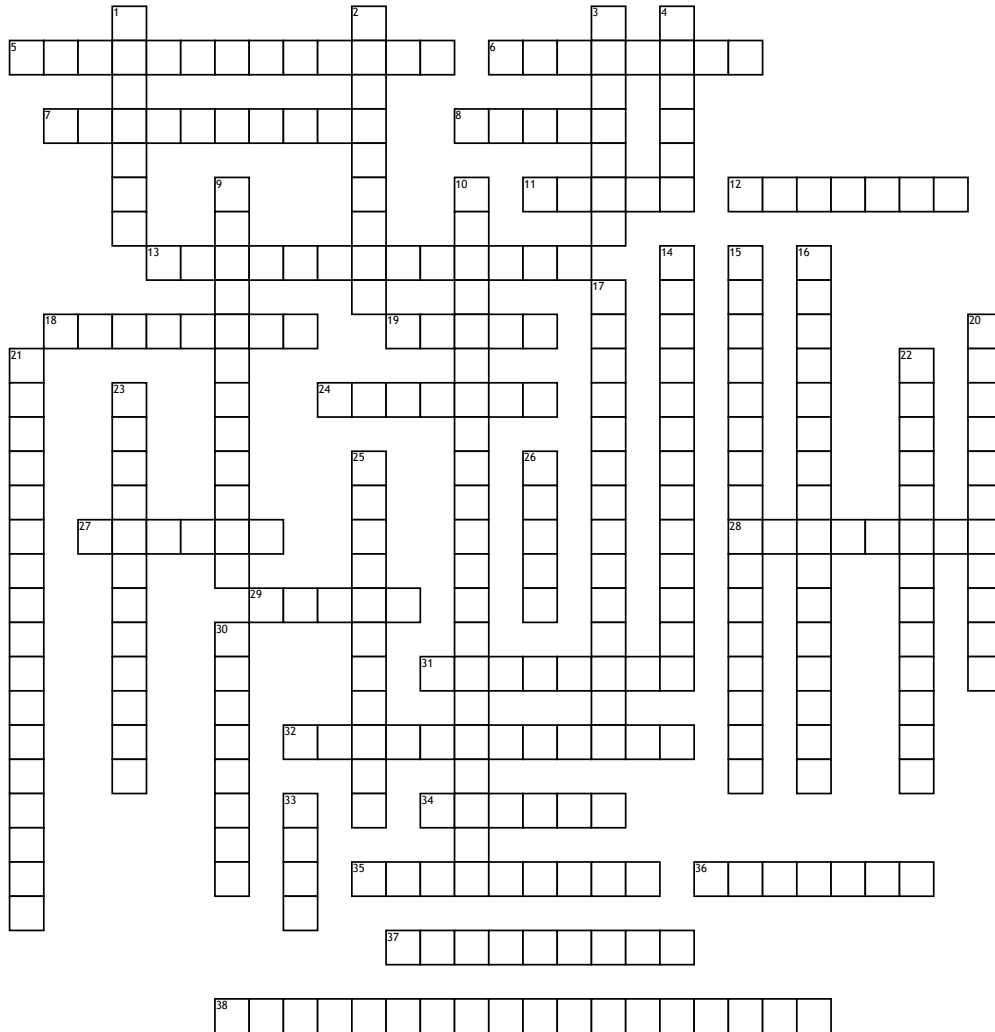


# Chapter 4 disease and disorders

- 5. Abnormal condition of excessive sweat caused by heat, genetics, or medications
- 6. Boil
- 7. Fungal condition, caused by yeast. Characterized by white, brown, or salmon-colored flaky patches
- 8. Secondary lesion; dead cells that form over a wound or blemish while healing
- 11. Epidermal cysts; small, firm papules with no visible opening
- 12. Type of hormonal hyperpigmentation disorder that first appears during pregnancy or with the use of birth control pills.
- 13. Prickly he; acute inflammatory disorder of the sweat glands
- 18. A contagious skin infection characterized by clusters of small blisters or crusty lesions
- 19. Abnormal cell mass that results from excessive cell multiplication and varies in size
- 24. Crack in the skin that penetrates the dermis; chapped lips or hands are fissures
- 27. Thick scar resulting from excessive growth of fibrous tissue (collagen)

- 28. Sebaceous cyst or subcutaneous tumor filled with sebum
- 29. Itchy, swollen lesion caused by a blow, insect bite, skin allergy reaction, or stings
- 31. Persistent itching
- 32. Foul smelling perspiration found on armpits or feet
- 34. Mass of hardened sebum and skin cells in a hair follicle
- 35. Abnormally thick buildup of cells
- 36. Small outgrowth or extension of skin that looks like a flap
- 37. Severe oiliness of the skin
- 38. Most common and least severe type of skin cancer

- 10. Second most serious form of skin cancer; characterized by scaly red or pink papules or nodules
- 14. Also known as ringworm
- 15. Redness and bumpiness in the cheeks or upper arms; caused by blocked follicles
- 16. Pink or flesh colored precancerous lesions, that feel sharp or rough
- 17. Pink eye
- 20. Skin sore or abrasion produced by scratching or scraping the skin
- 21. Overproduction of pigment
- 22. Thick, brittle, discolored nails
- 23. Also known as shingles; a painful viral infection skin condition from the chicken pox virus
- 25. Branch of medical science that studies and treats the skin and it's disorders.
- 26. Swelling caused by a fluid imbalance in cells or a response to injury or infection
- 30. Also known as hives; caused by an allergic reaction from the body's histamine production
- 33. Contains fluid, infection, and other matter above or below the skin
