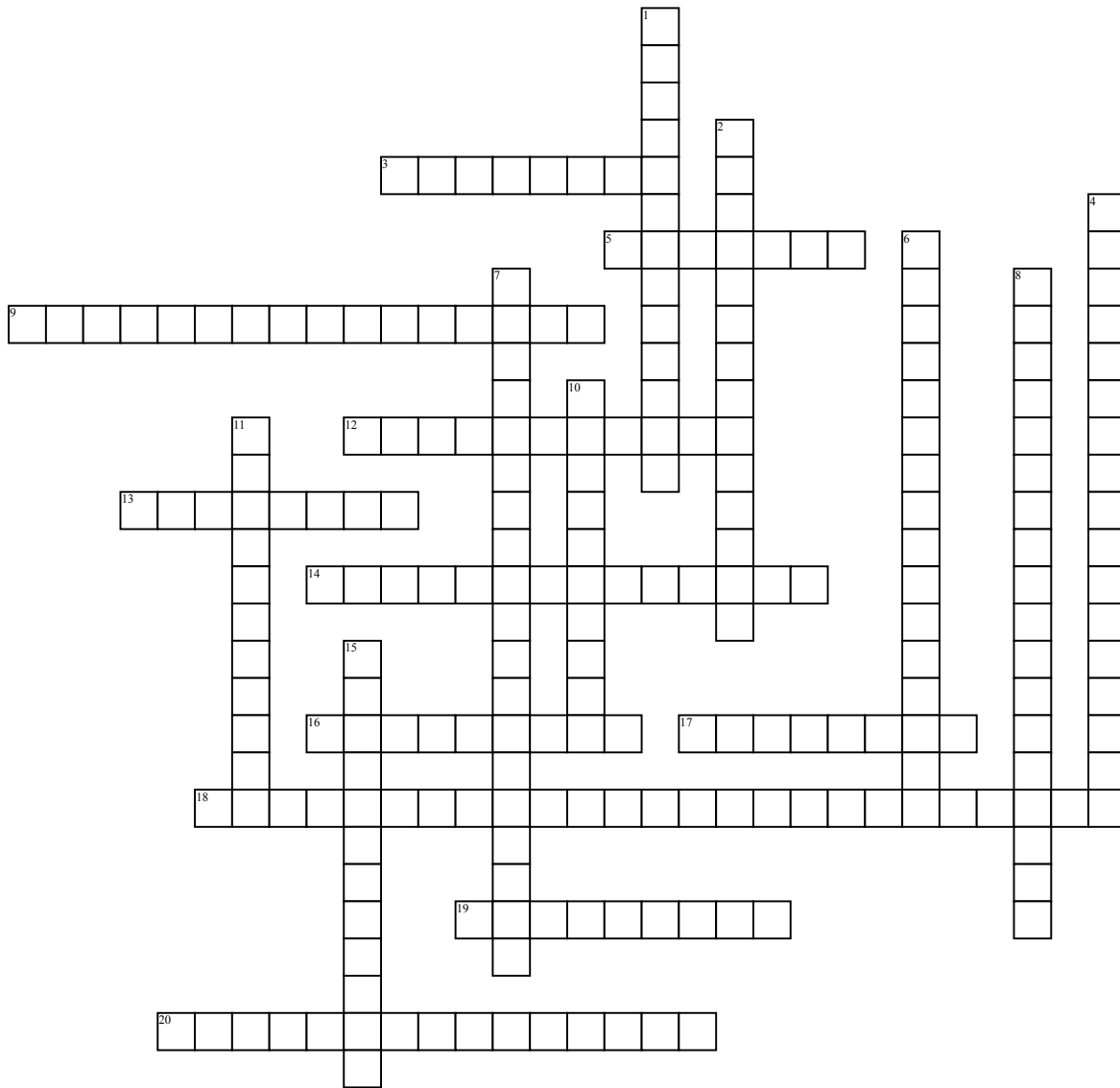


Chapter 5-6 Crossword Puzzle
