 13. Affect the side of the neck and the platysma muscle
 14. Affects the muscles behind the ear at the base of the skull
 15. Affects the muscles of the temple, side of forehead, eyebrow, eyelid and upper cheek
 16. Affects the muscles of the upper part of the cheek
 17. Accessory nerve, controls the neck and shoulder muscles
 18. Located at the side of the neck, affects the front and sides of the neck goes down breastbone
 19. Located at the side of neck, affects the face, ears, neck, and parotid gland
 20. Located in the back of the head, affects the scalp as far up as the top of the head
