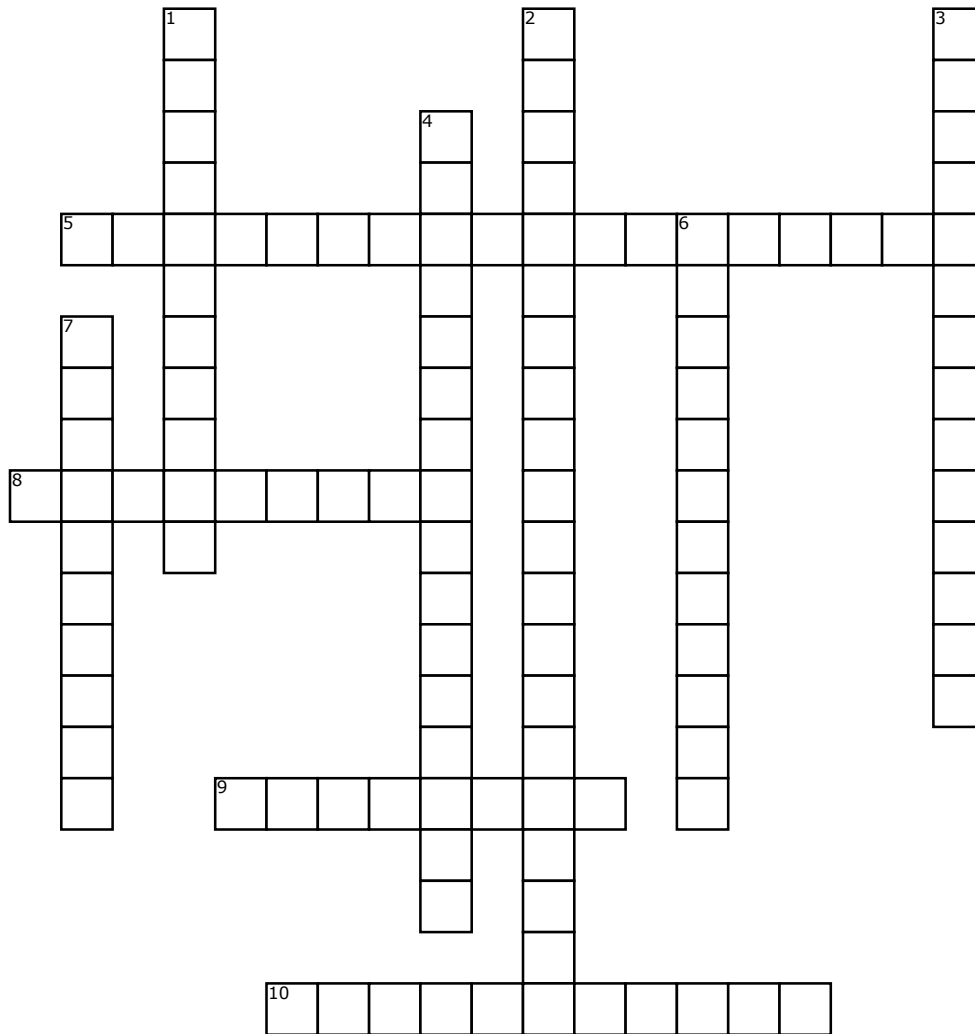


Chapter 8: The Digestive System

4. ring-like muscle at the base of the stomach that controls the flow of partially digested food from the stomach to the duodenum of the small intestine.

6. is a protrusion of part of the stomach through the esophageal sphincter in the diaphragm

7. The breaking down of body cells or substances, releasing energy and carbon dioxide.
