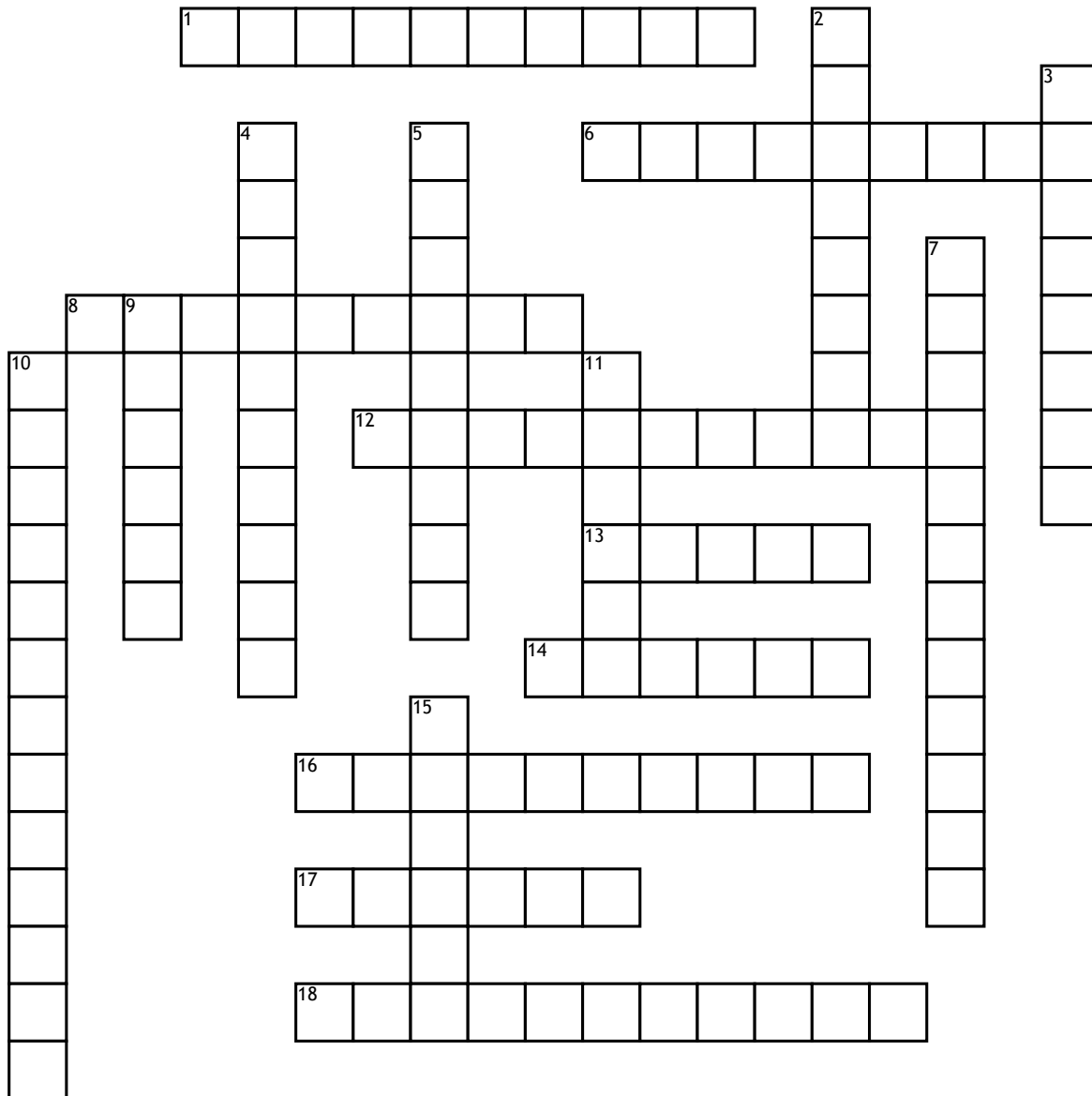


# Child Development - Pregnancy

7. high blood pressure/pregnancy-induced hypertension

9. a thick white protective coating that covers the fetus
