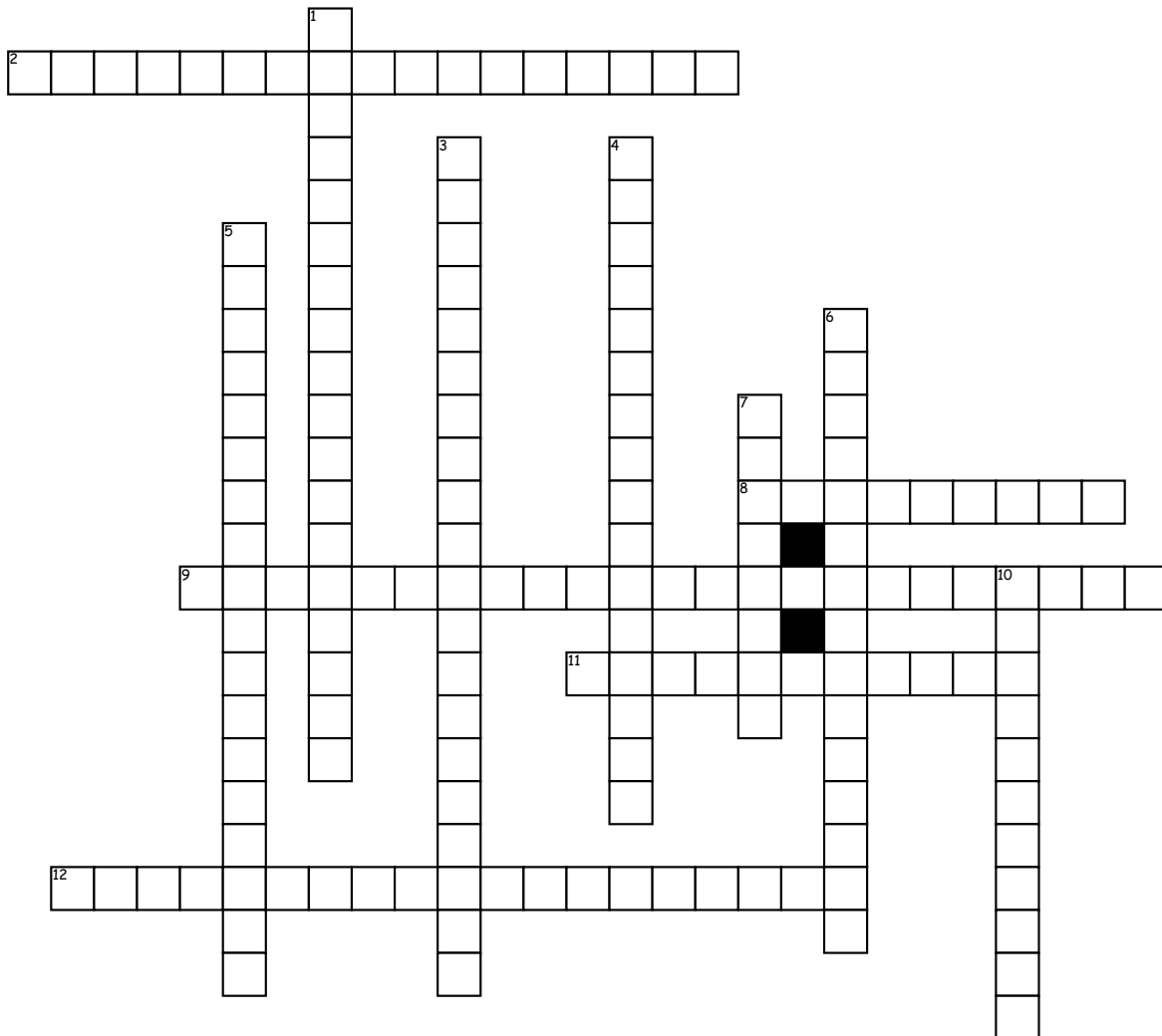

- 1. Piaget's earliest stage of cognitive development teaching that an infant is only limited to his own sensory perceptions
- 3. Child's ability to express and manage emotions, as well as begin empathizing
- 4. The understanding that objects still exist even if they aren't visible
- 5. When child experiences stranger anxiety, but does not subside when caregiver returns
- 6. Occurs when clingy child is introduced to someone besides the original caregiver and shows a form of distress
- 7. An involuntary movement occurring because of a stimulus
