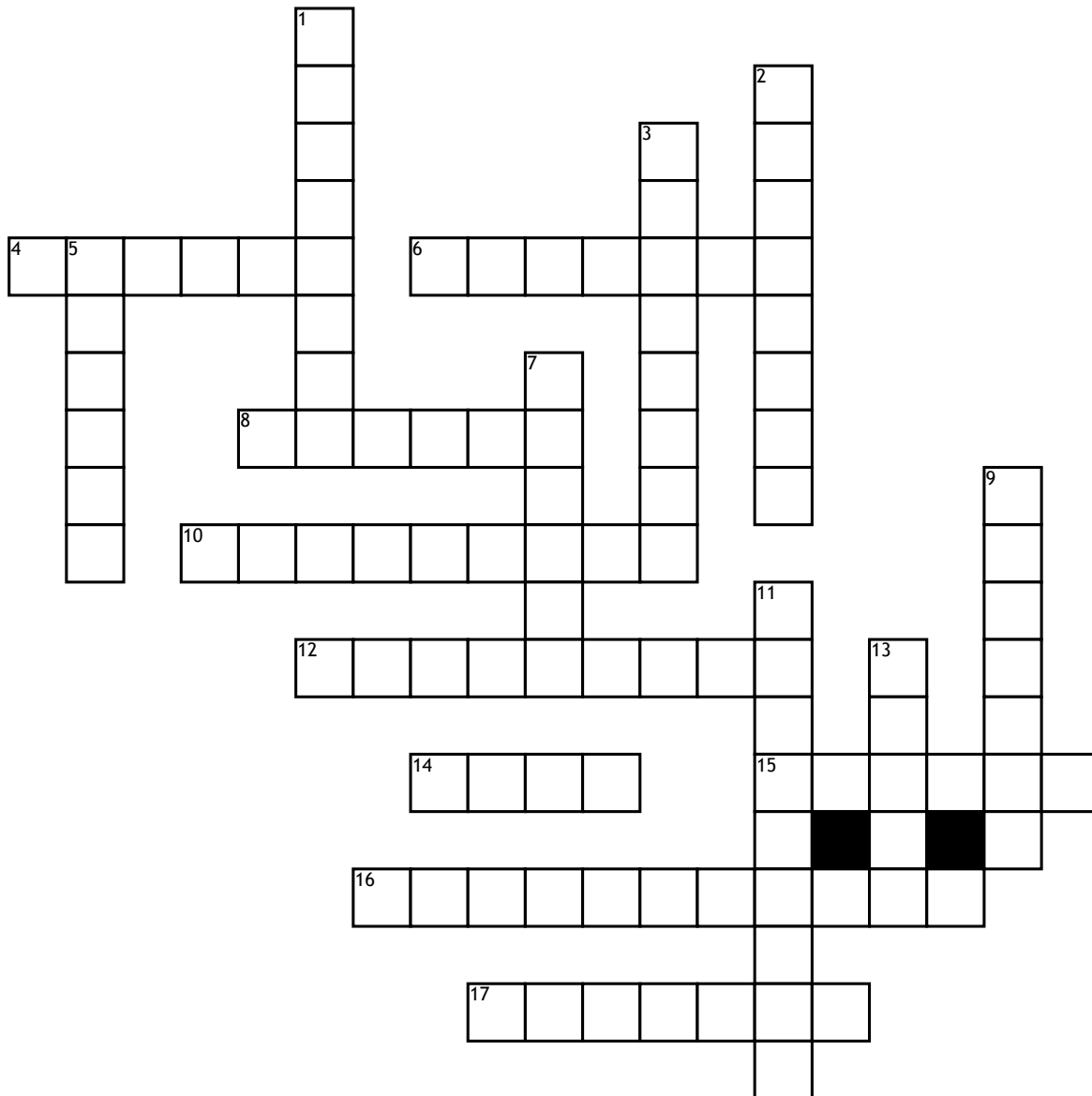


Chile Earthquake Crossword
