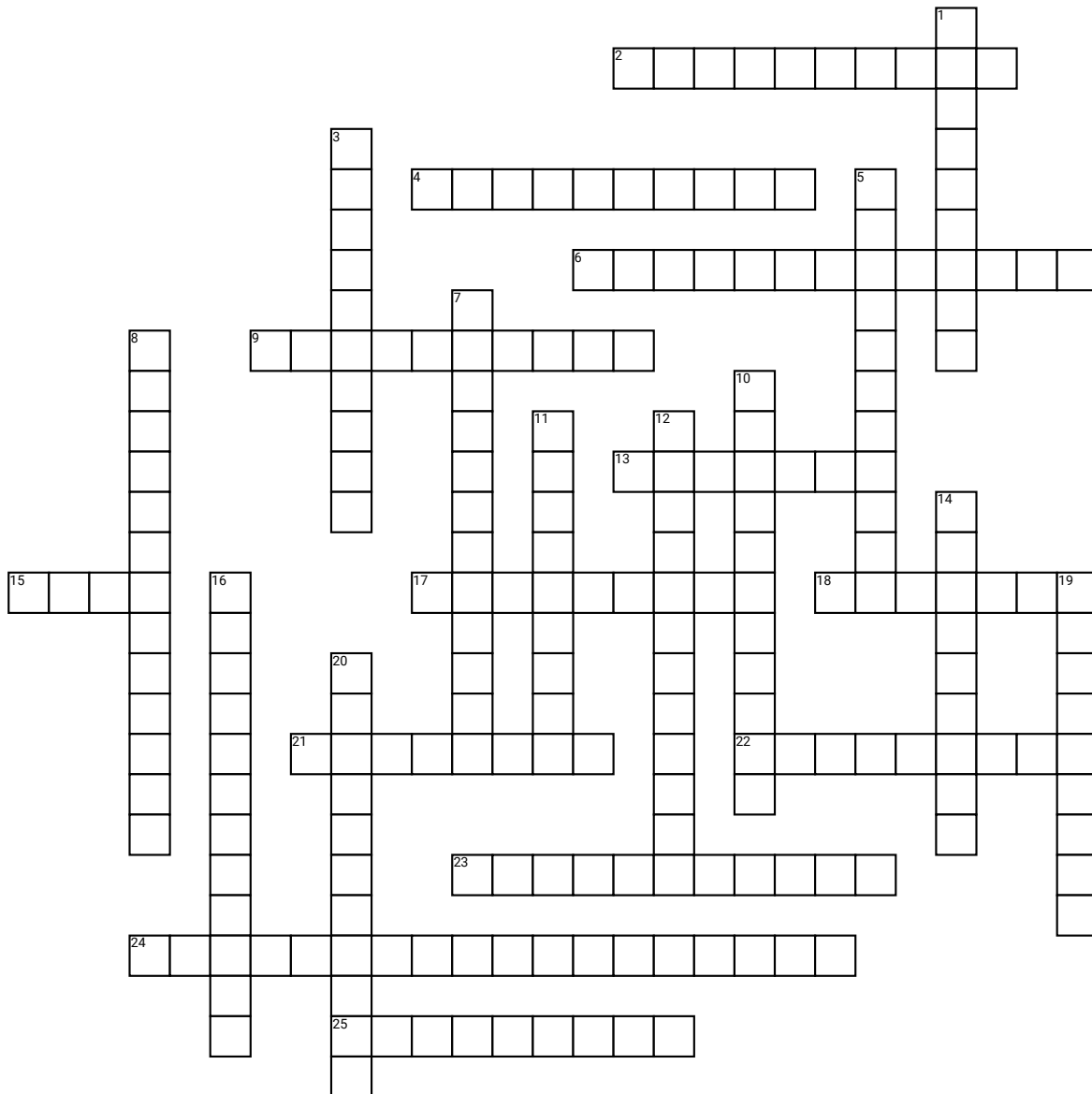

- 2. space below the glottis
- 4. raises the floor of the mouth for swallowing and depresses the mandible when the hyoid is stabilized
- 6. thinning or loss of the superficial layer of VF tissue
- 9. thin covering of the vocal folds
- 13. cartilaginous structure that allows air to pass from nose into the lungs
- 15. growth found along the membranous vocal fold
- 17. interferes with VF closure
- 18. often resembles leukoplakia

- 21. series of consecutive phoned frequencies
  - 22. the supra glottal space within the laryngeal cavity
  - 23. regularity of successive cycles of vibration during phonation
  - 24. allows you to look into the larynx with a strobe light
  - 25. when the glottis is closed
