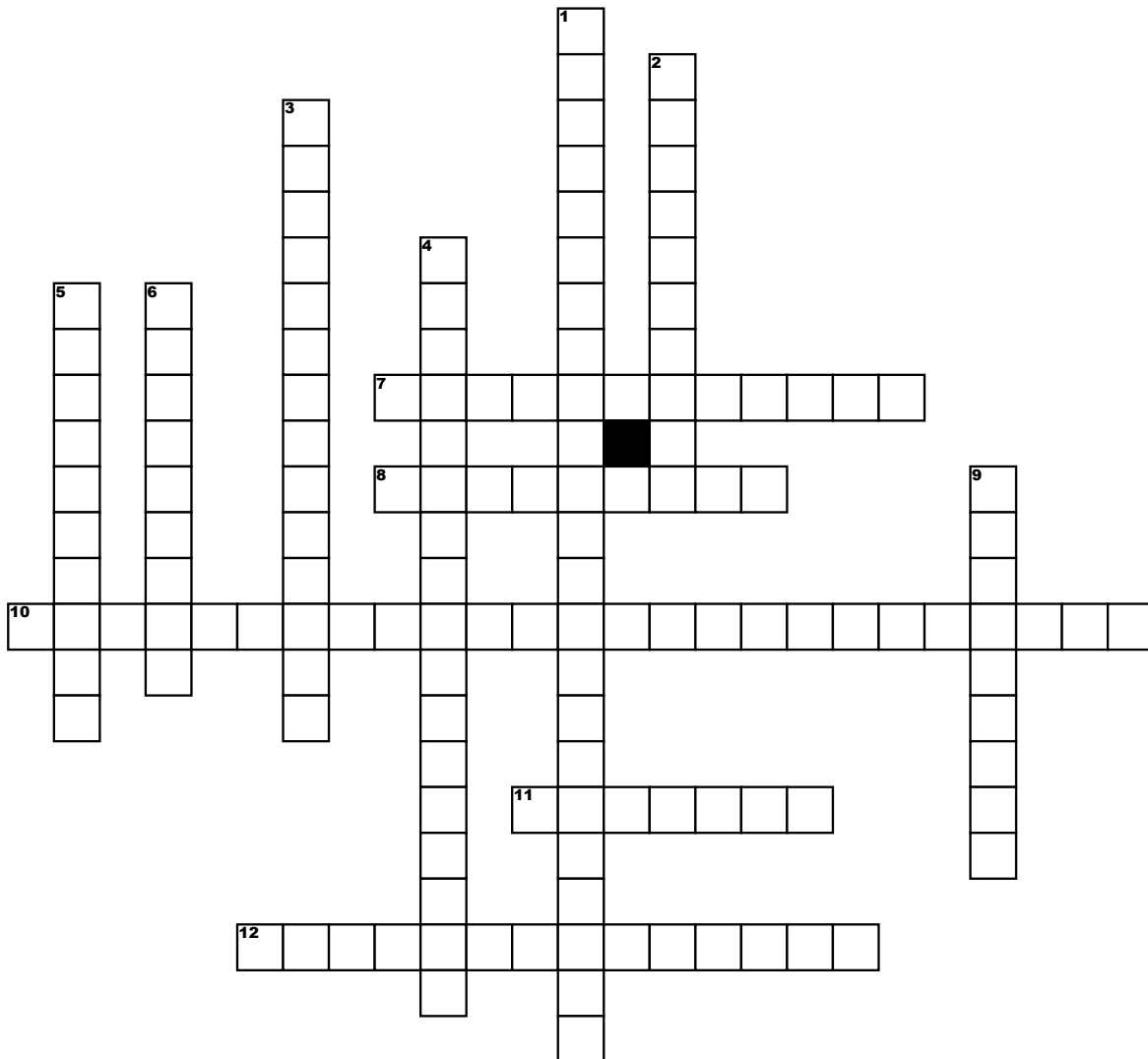


Choice board crossword
