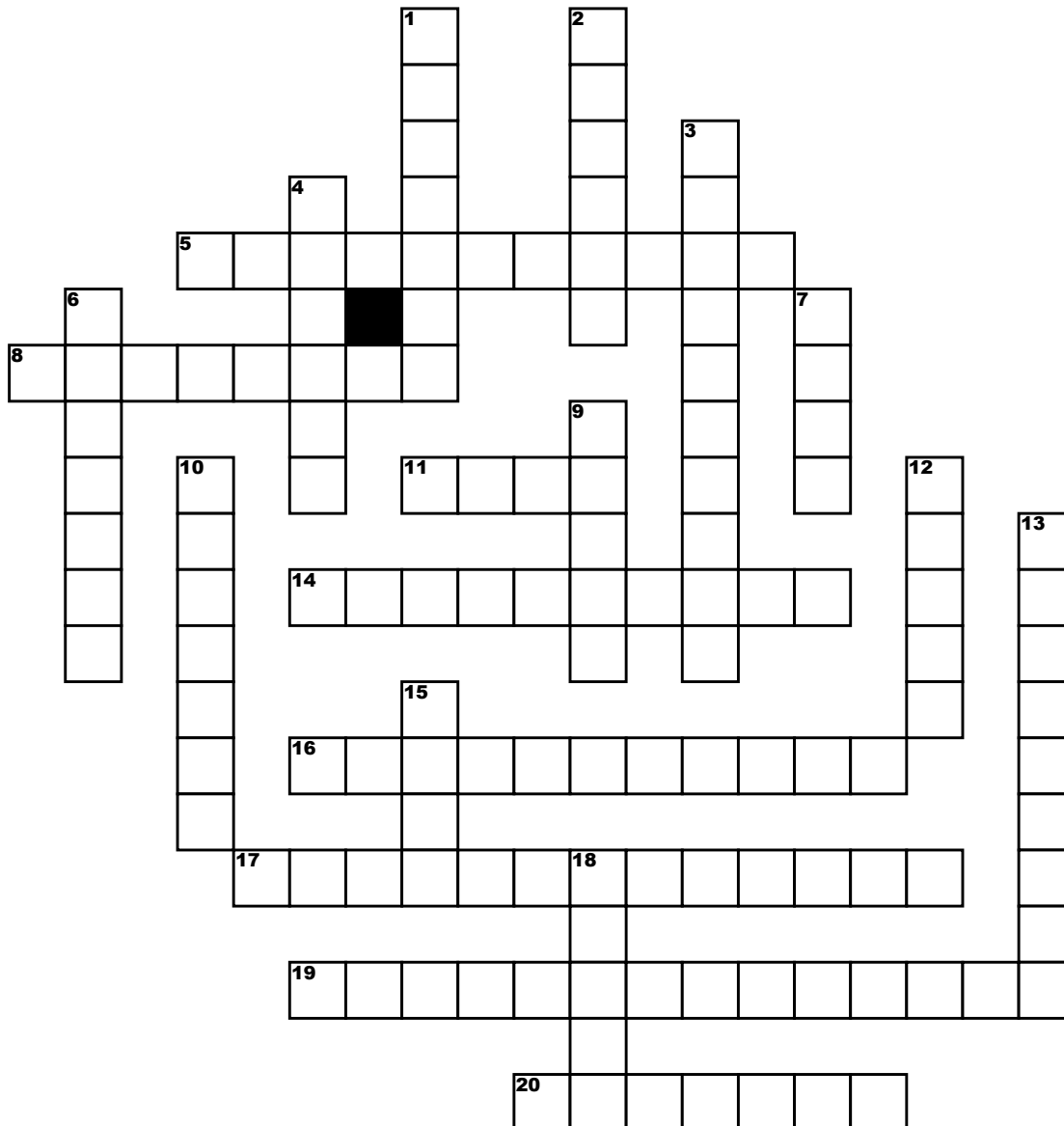


# Choir Crossword
