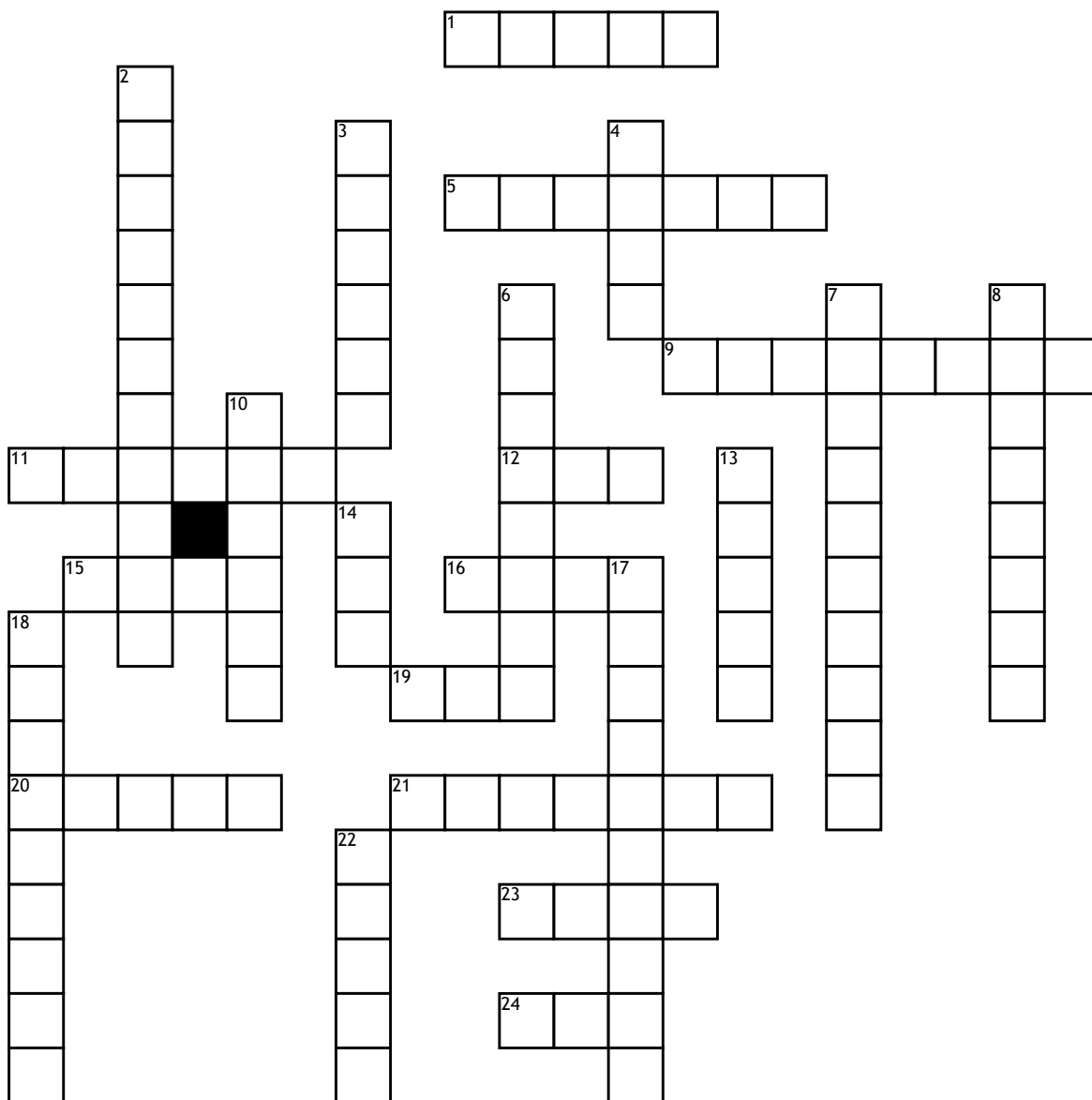


# Christmas Craker
