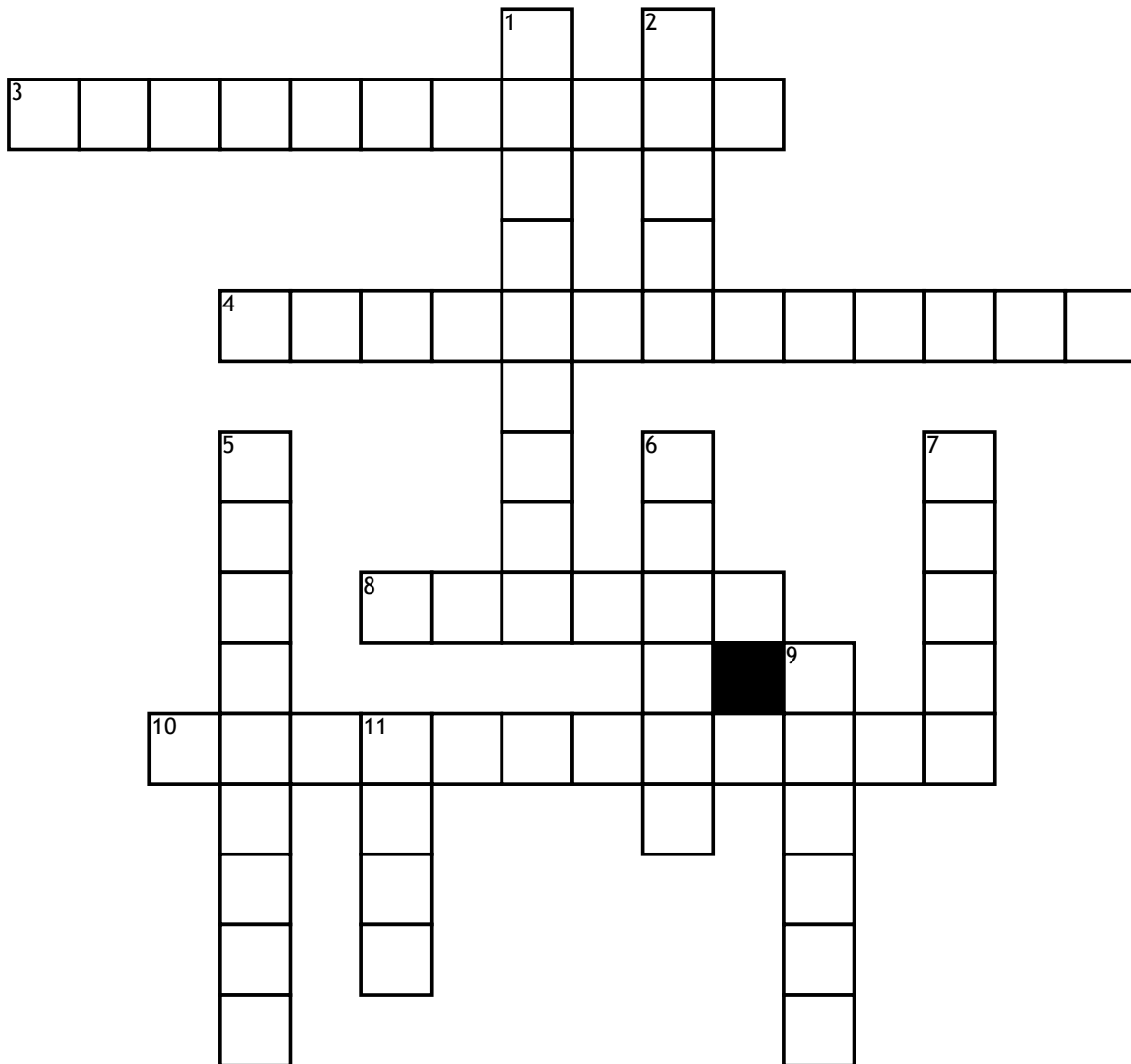


# Christmas Surprise!
