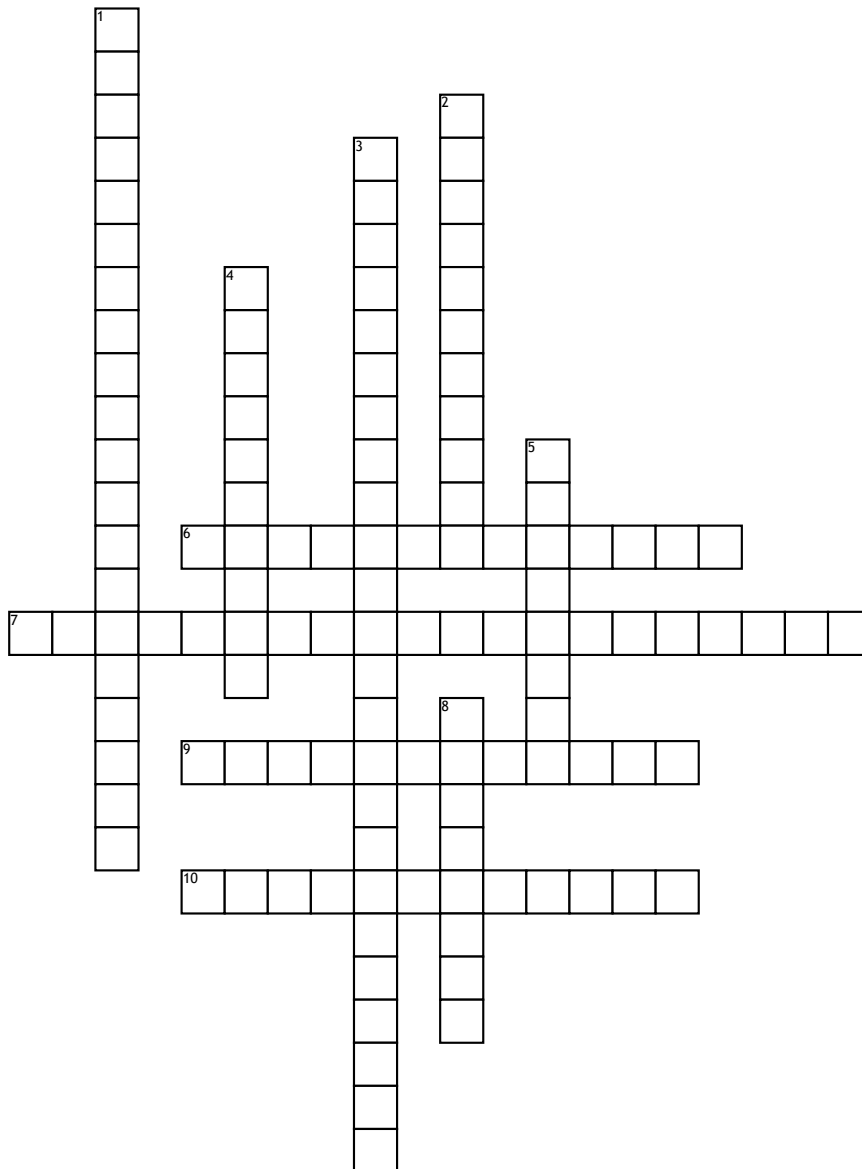


Chronic Kidney Disease
