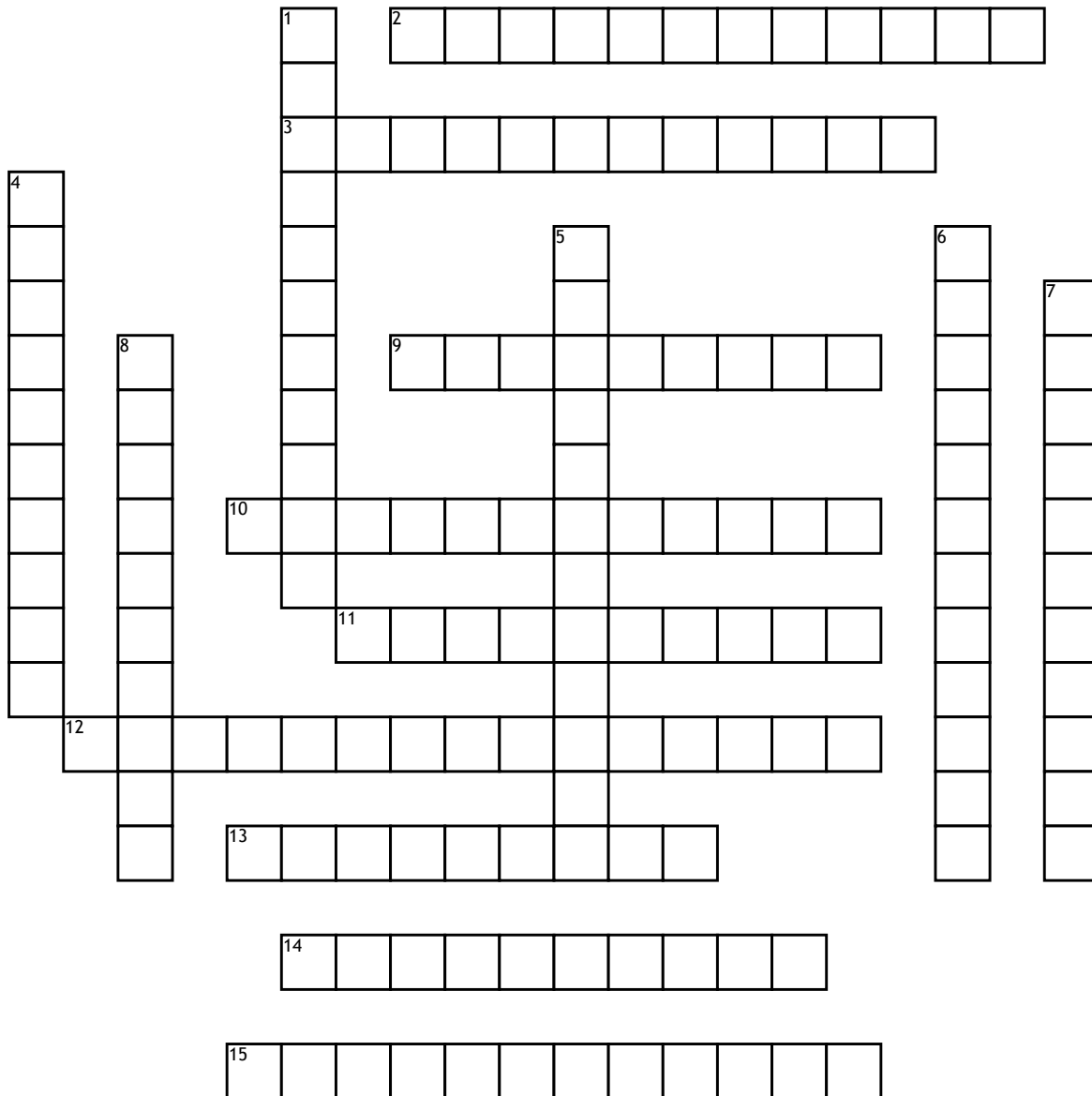


Circulatory Medical Terms

2. Bleeding from the uterus not associated with menstruation
 3. A nucleated, spindle-shaped cell of nonmammalian vertebrates that promotes blood clotting.
 9. An abnormally large red blood cell
 10. An abnormally low level of red blood cells, white blood cells, and platelets in the circulating blood.
 11. White blood cells
 12. A glycoprotein hormone that stimulates the production of red blood cells by stem cells in bone marrow.

15. A disease of the ear in which the movement of the stapes within the oval window becomes impeded by abnormal deposits of spongy bone, leading to a progressive loss of hearing.

1. Radiologic visualization of the arteries following injection of a radiopaque substance.

4. The stoppage of blood flow through a blood vessel or body part

5. The branch of medicine that deals with the diagnosis and treatment of diseases and disorders of the heart.

6. The production of electrical impulses by living tissues or organisms, such as the electric eel.

7. A rapid heart rate, especially one above 100 beats per minute in an adult.

8. The curve traced by a cardiograph, used in the diagnosis of heart disorders.
