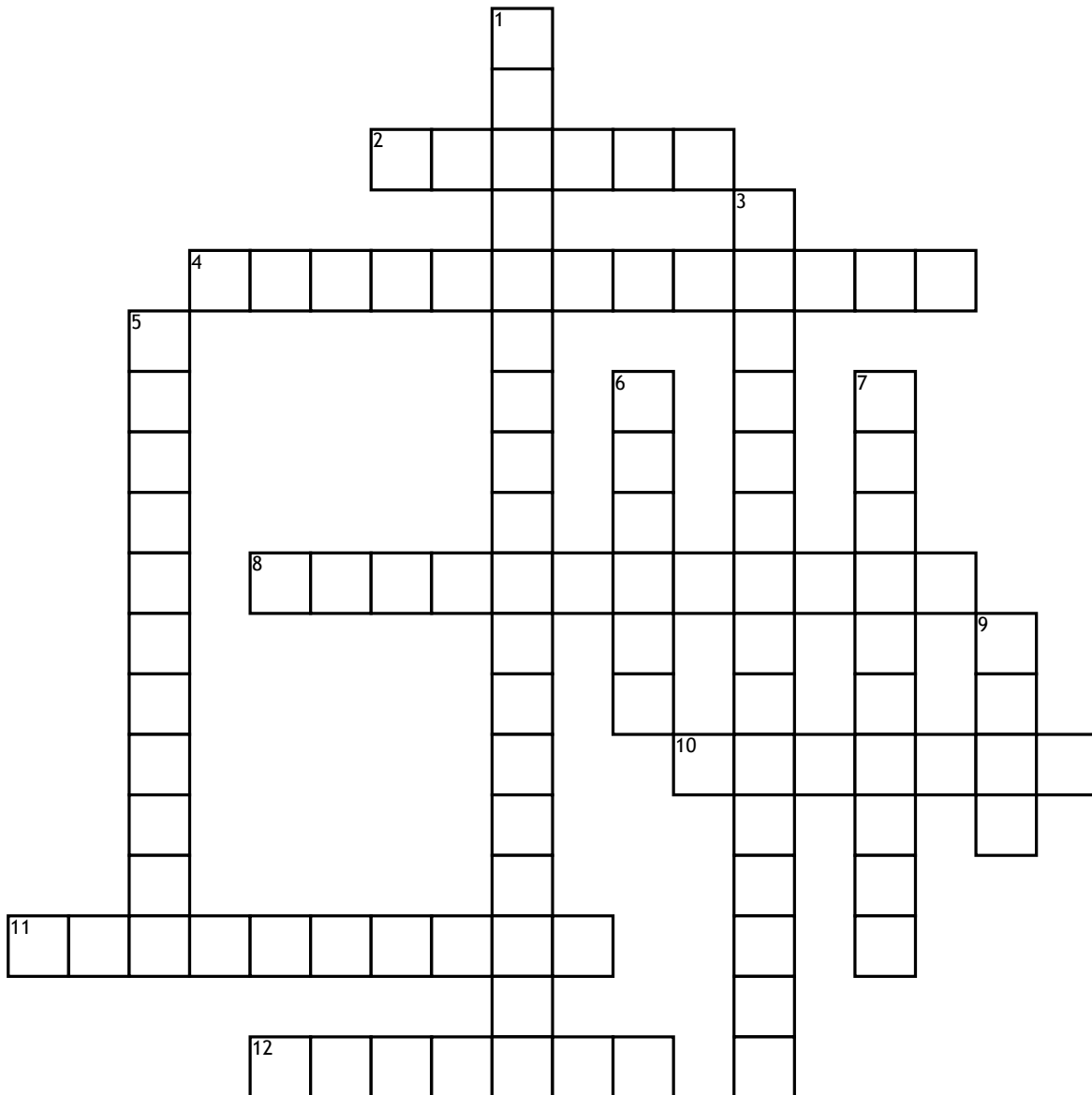

1. Most common dysrhythmia; atria quivers

3. The build up of fats, cholesterol, and other substances in and on the artery wall

5. Class of medication used to treat htn and cardiac arrhythmias by blocking effects of epinephrine and norepinephrine on B adrenergic receptors

6. Carries oxygen rich blood from the heart; has a pulse

7. Left anterior descending artery of the heart

9. Carries oxygen deficient blood
