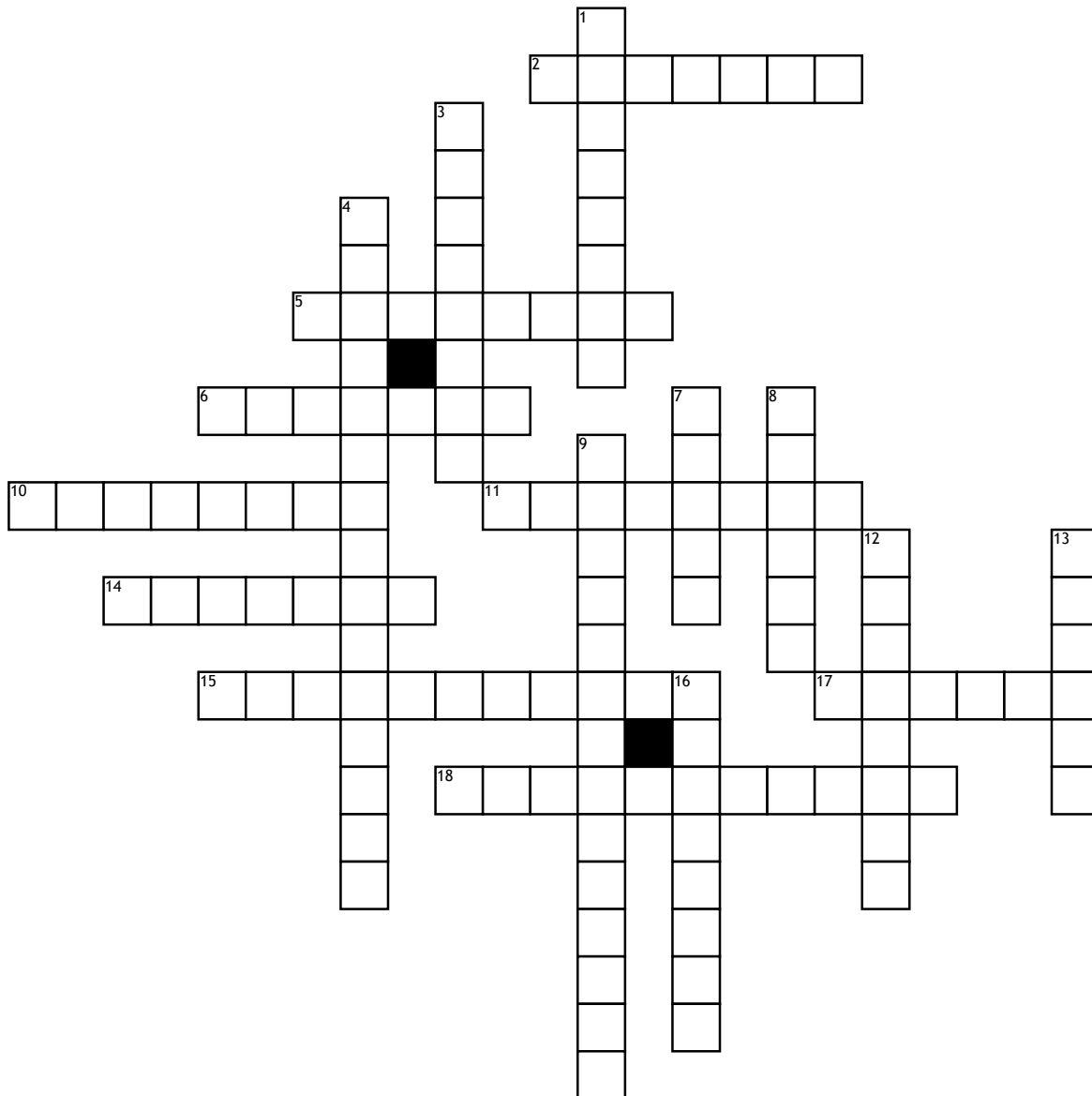


# Citizenship
