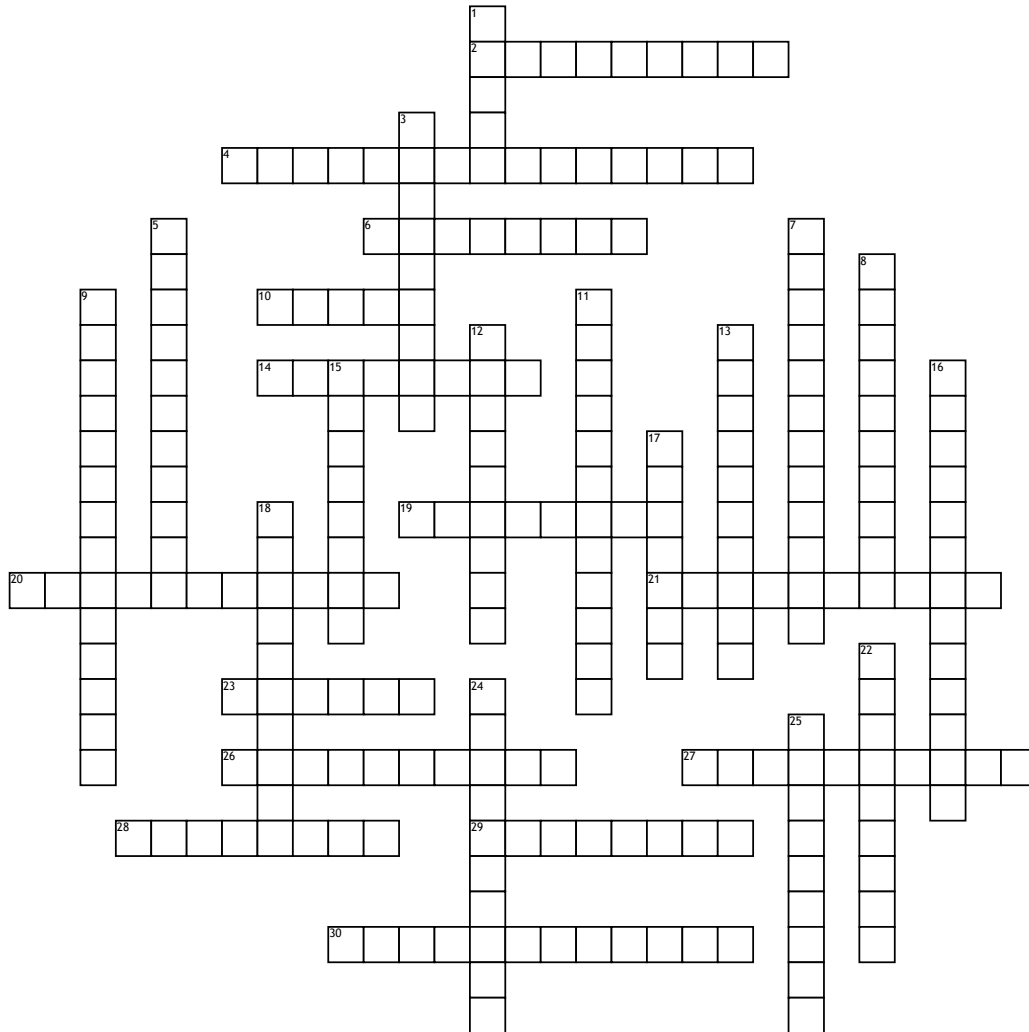

- 1. The debate or conflict among individuals or parties having or hoping to achieve power
 - 3. The citizens exercise supreme power either on their own or through elected representatives
 - 5. Independent state where people share a similar culture
 - 7. A single person exercises supreme power by controlling military and police
 - 8. Institutions organized to establish and carry out public policy
 - 9. Unwritten agreement between the government and the people to promote the common good
 - 11. a democratic and republic system of government where the head leads an executive branch separately from the legislative branch
 - 12. a single political party runs the economy
 - 13. an economic and political system in which a country's trade is owned by private owners for profit, rather than by the state.
 - 15. the state of being equal
 - 16. Cunning or ruthless methods to obtain and maintain power
 - 17. Totalitarian system where businesses remain in private hands but under gov. control
 - 18. Legislative assembly in which elected representatives debate and promote laws
 - 22. An economic system that calls for public ownership of the means of production
 - 24. Power is divided between a central gov. and a smaller regional gov.
