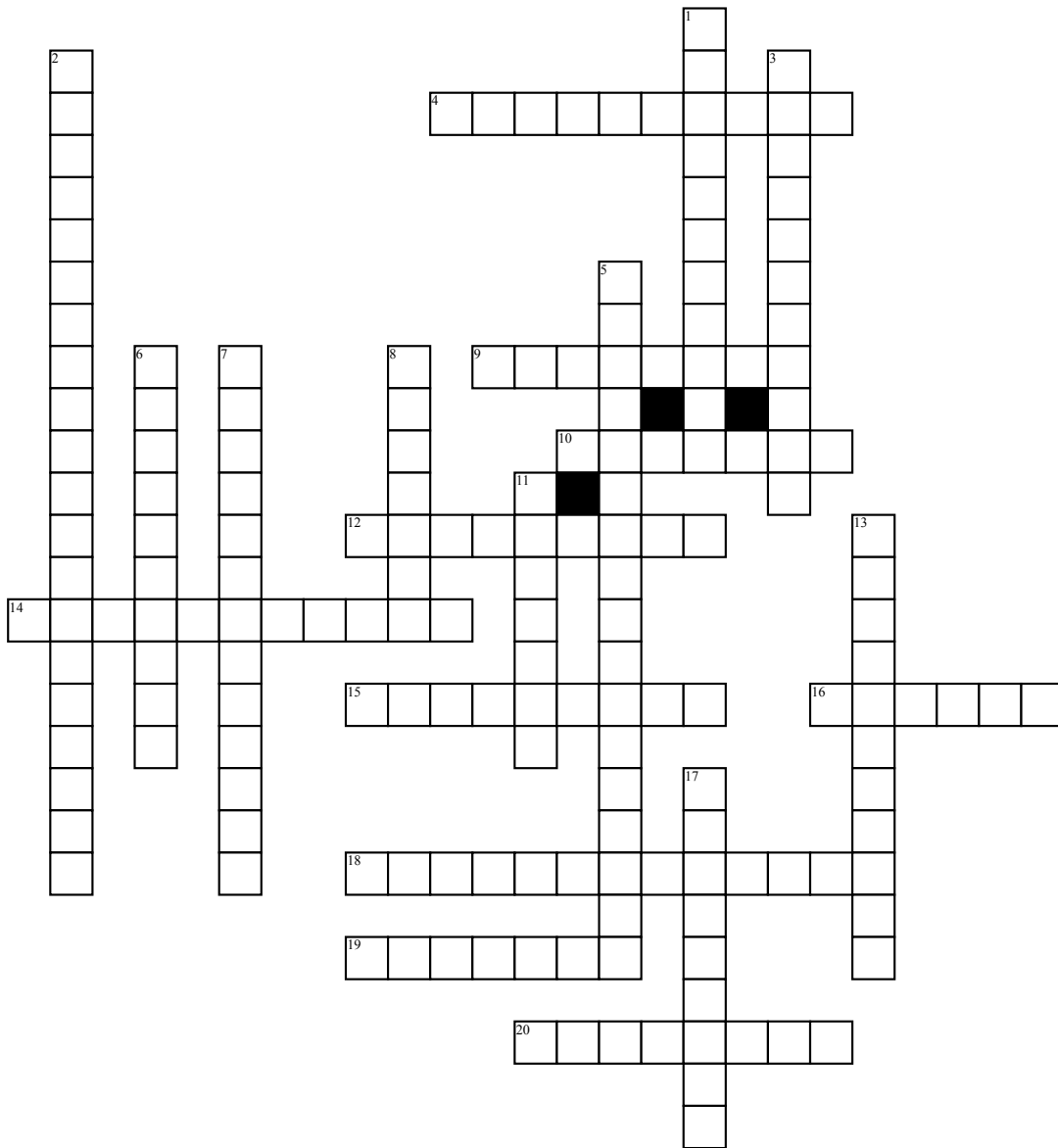

4. A case heard only by a judge; not a jury
 9. Requires someone to testify in court
 10. Laws that apply to an entire country or state
 12. Cases bound by a precedent
 14. Confined to one's home
 15. Jail sentence can be avoided with supervision and restriction (parole)
 16. Serious crimes including murder and arson

18. Locked up in a prison or mental institution
 19. Jury determines guilty or not guilty
 20. Vote of innocence (not guilty)

1. Issuing a plea of guilty, not guilty, or no contest
 2. Requirement more than 50% of the evidence points to guilt
 3. Issue search warrants and arrest warrants
 5. Another term used for the death penalty

6. Privilege is taken away for a period of time
 7. Right to remain silent, right to an attorney
 8. Requests someone to testify in court
 11. Plaintiff claims a civil wrong, usually has to do with negligence
 13. Lesser offenses including vandalism and theft
