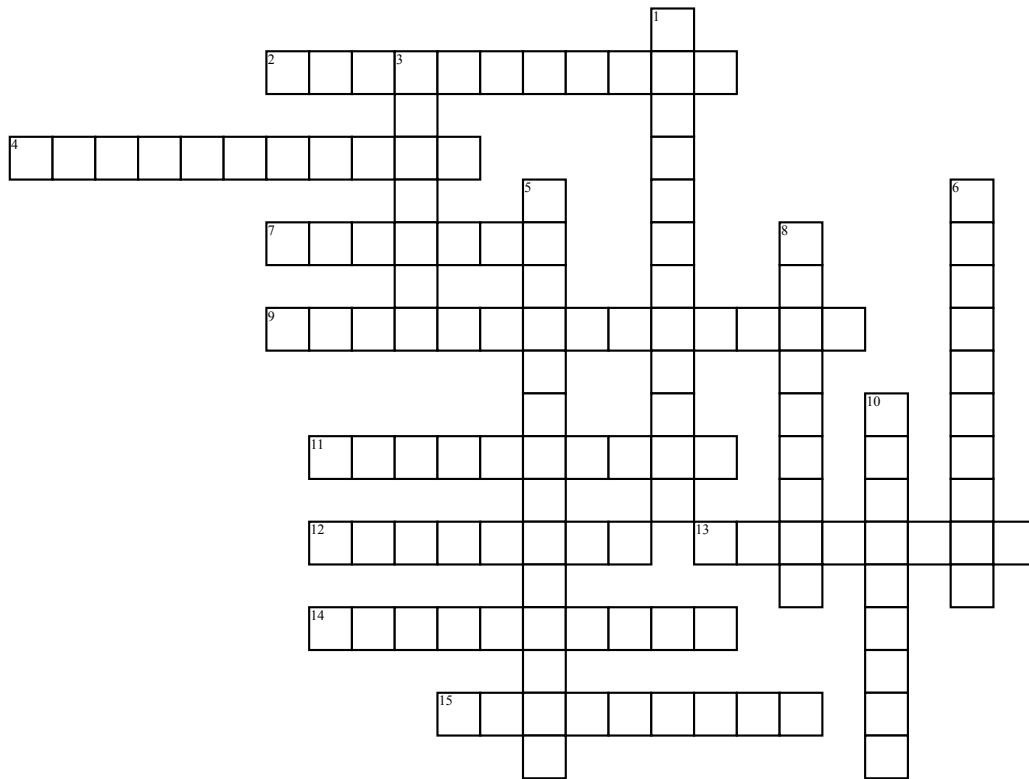


# Civil Disobedience
