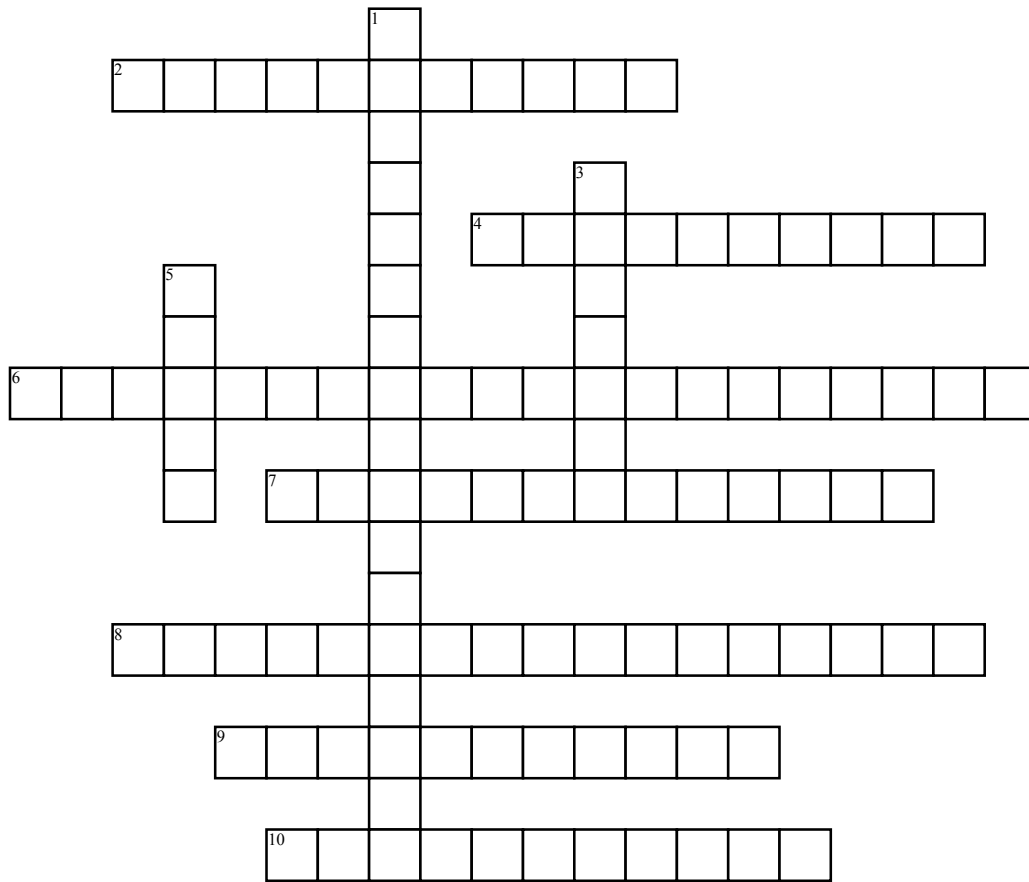


Civil Right Terms

2. 1961 event organized by CORE and SNCC in which an interracial group of civil rights activists tested southern states' compliance to the Supreme Court ban segregation on interstate buses
4. a tactic in which senators prevent a vote on a measure by taking the floor and refusing to stop talking
6. protest in 1955-1956 by African Americans against racial segregation in the bus system of Montgomery, Alabama
7. constitutional amendment ratified in 1964 to outlaw the poll tax

8. 1963 civil rights demonstration in Washington, D.C., in which protesters called for "jobs and freedom"
9. process of bringing people of different races together
10. between, among, or involving people of different races

3. in the senate, 3/5 vote to limit debate and call for a vote on an issue
5. form of protest in which protesters sat themselves and refuse to move
