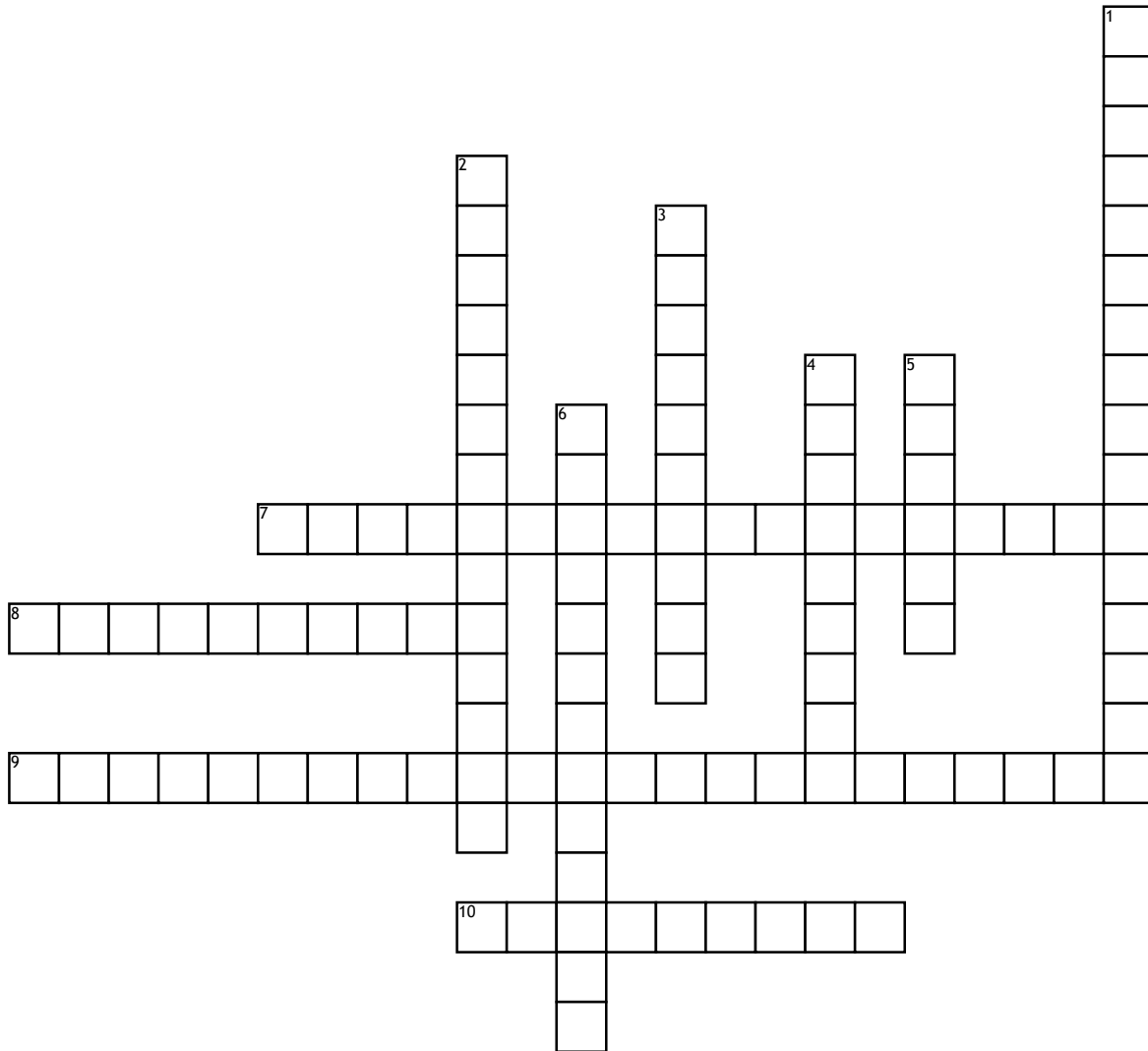


Civil Rights Crossword
