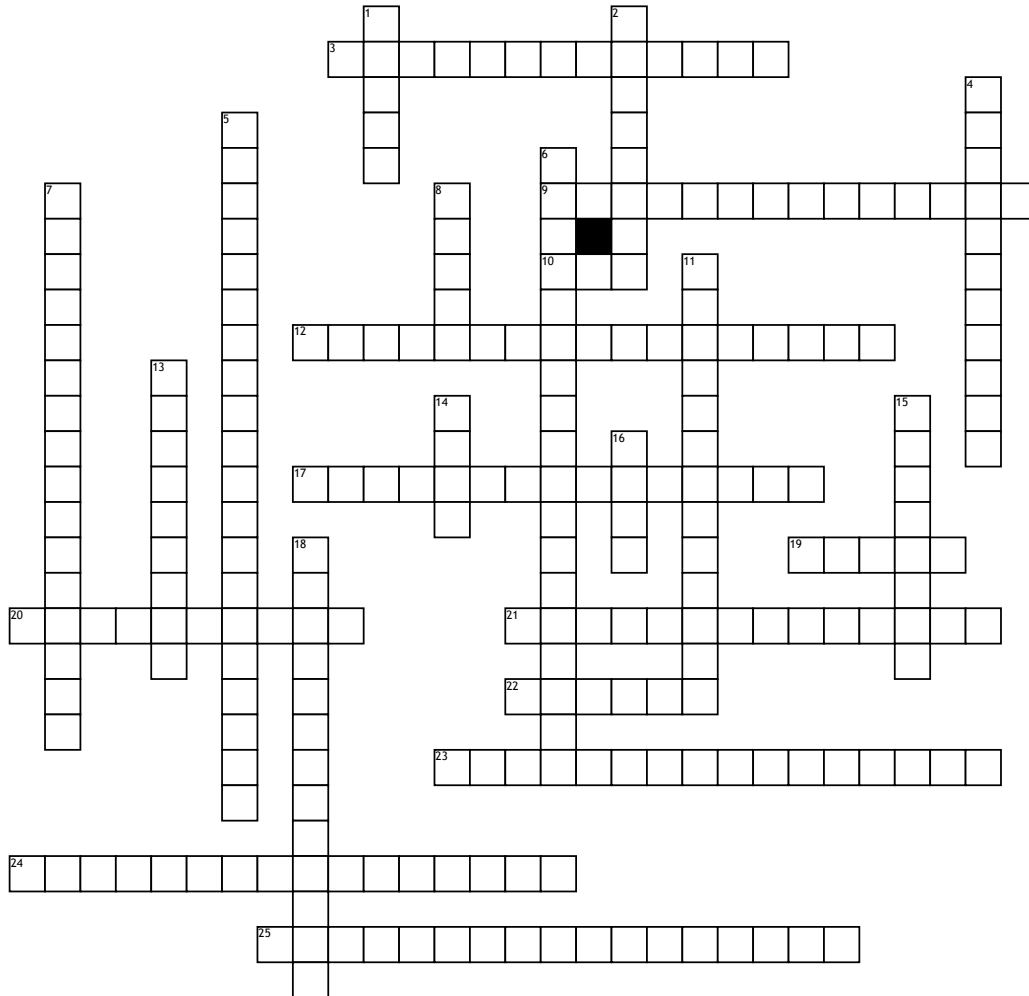


# Civil Rights Crossword
