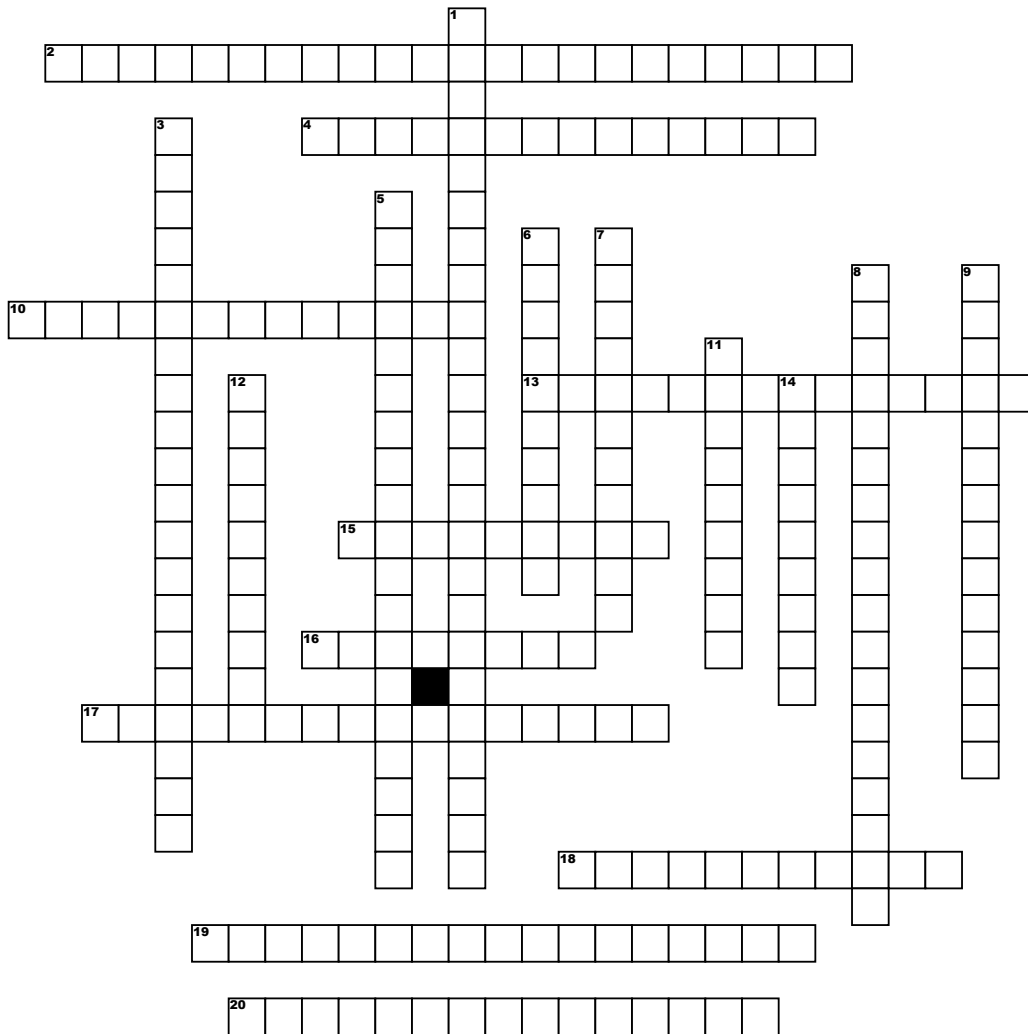


Civil War Cross Puzzle
