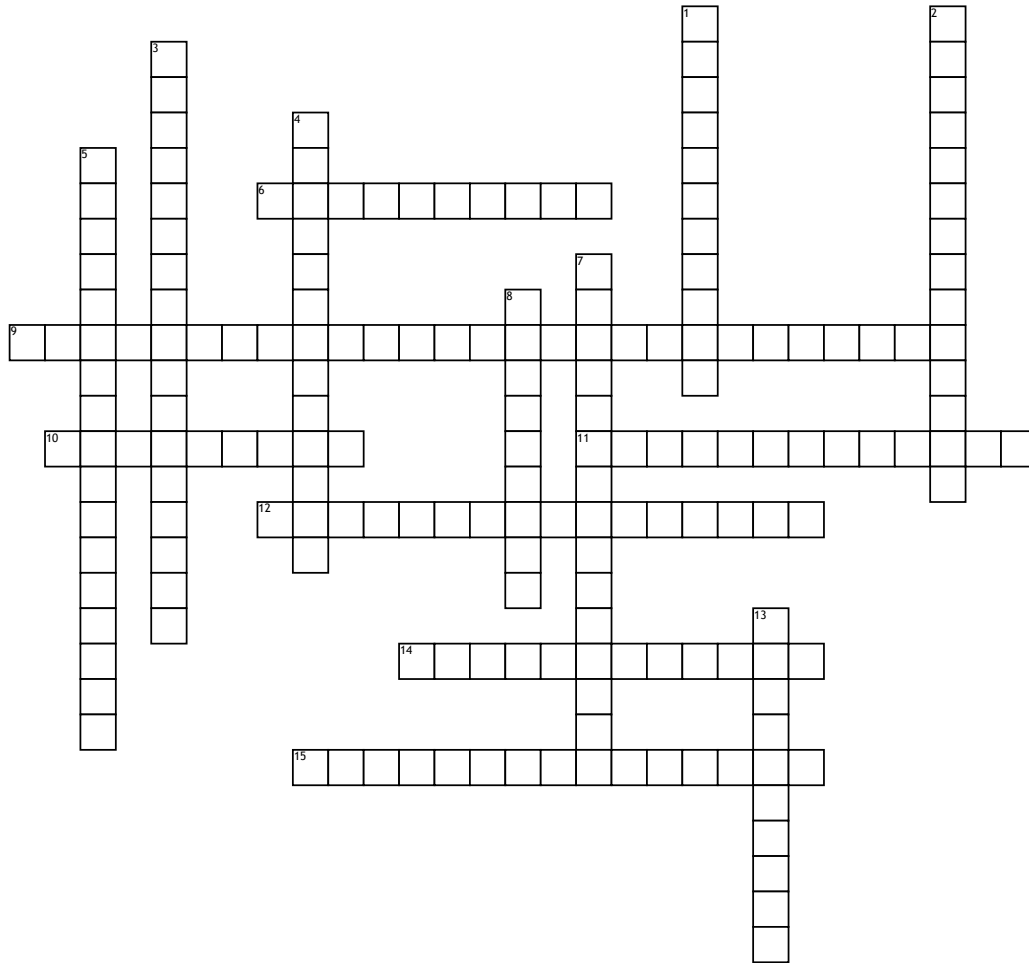


Civil War Cross Word Puzzle

- 14. A military strategy proposed by Union General Winfield Scott in the outbreak of the Civil War.
 - 15. An American soldier, businessman, educator, and author. He served as a general in the Union Army during the American Civil War.

- 1. A term used to describe the ongoing struggle over political power in the United States between the federal government and individual states as broadly outlined in the Tenth Amendment.
 - 2. Was an American statesman and lawyer who served as the 16th president of the United States from 1861 to 1865.
 - 3. A speech that U.S. President Abraham Lincoln delivered during the American Civil War.

- 4. The action of a state impeding or attempting to prevent the operation and enforcement within its territory of a law of the U.S.
- 5. An American politician who served as the vice president of the Confederate States from 1861 to 1865.
- 7. A merchant vessel used for evading a naval blockade of a port or strait.
- 8. The withdrawal of eleven southern states from the Union in 1860, leading to the Civil War.
- 13. A statement executed by a Georgia Convention in Milledgeville, Georgia on December 10, 1850, in response to the Compromise of 1850.
