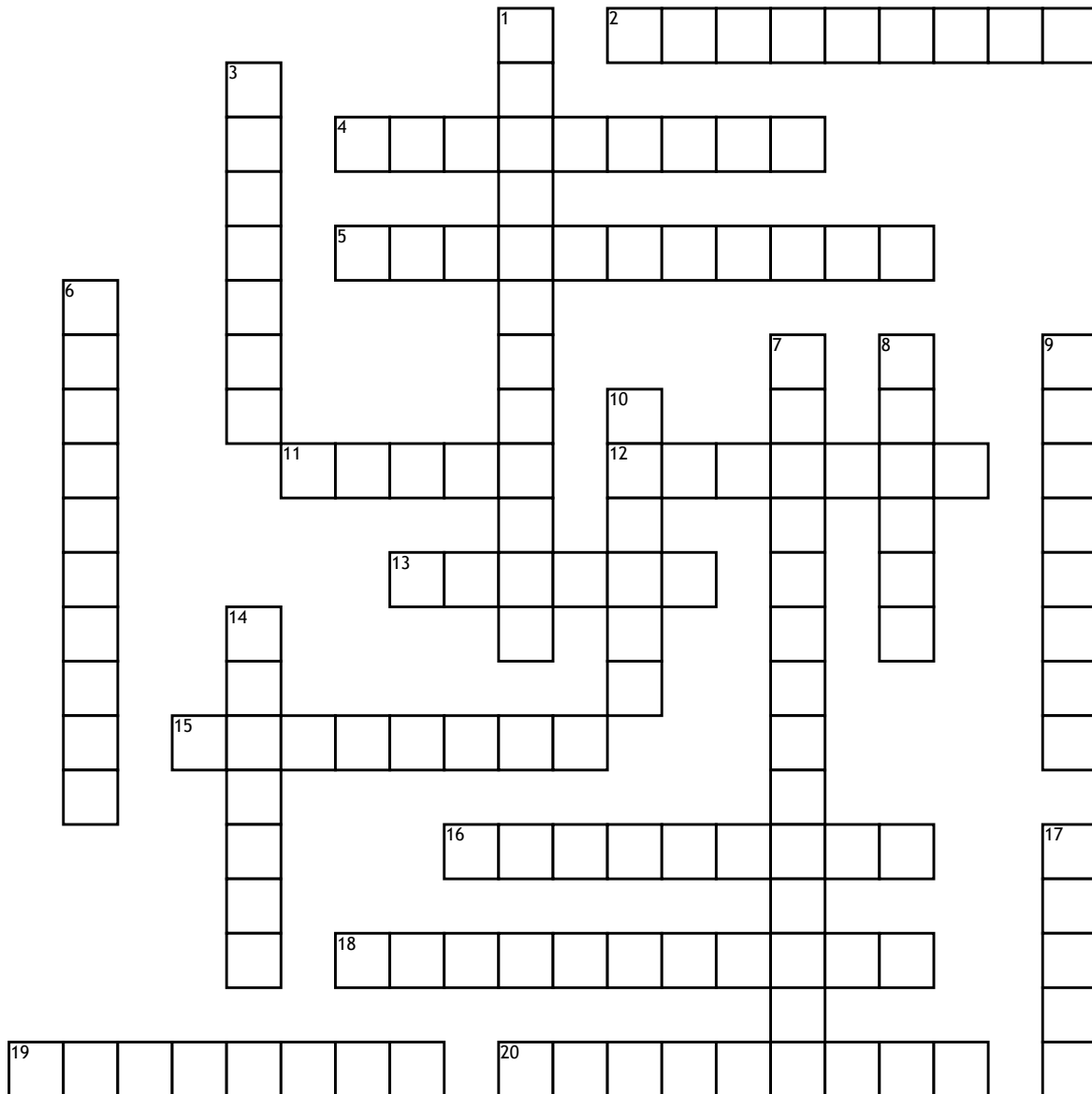


Civil War Crossword
