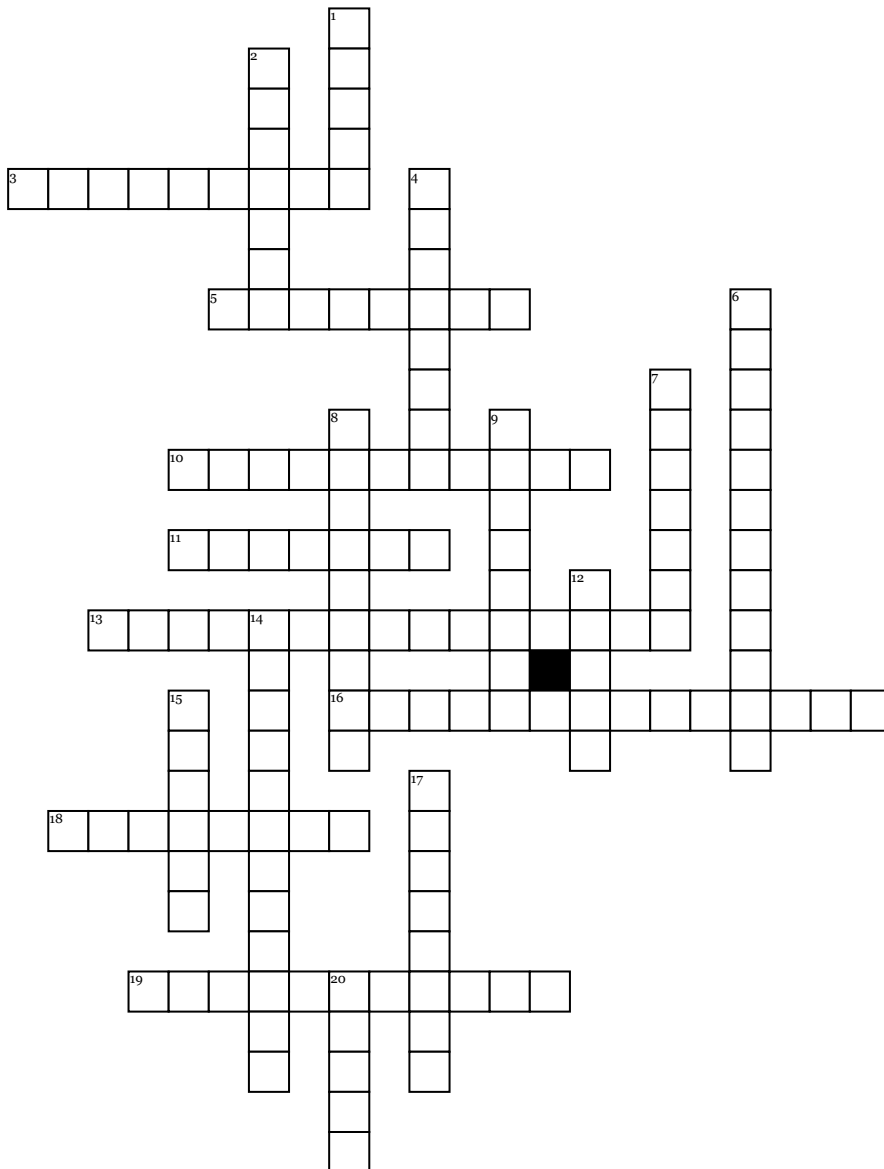


# Civil War Crossword
