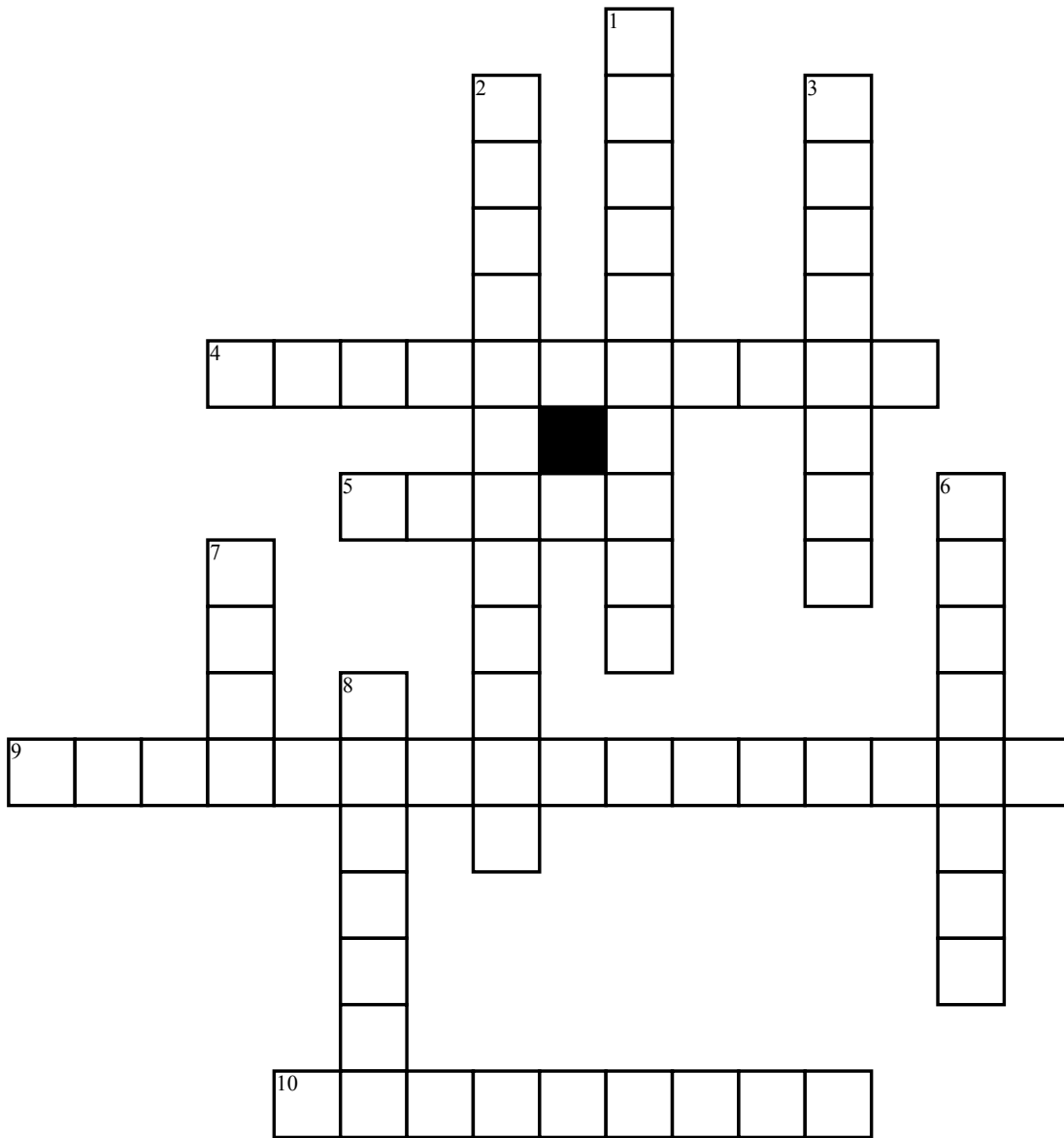


Civil War Puzzle: A
