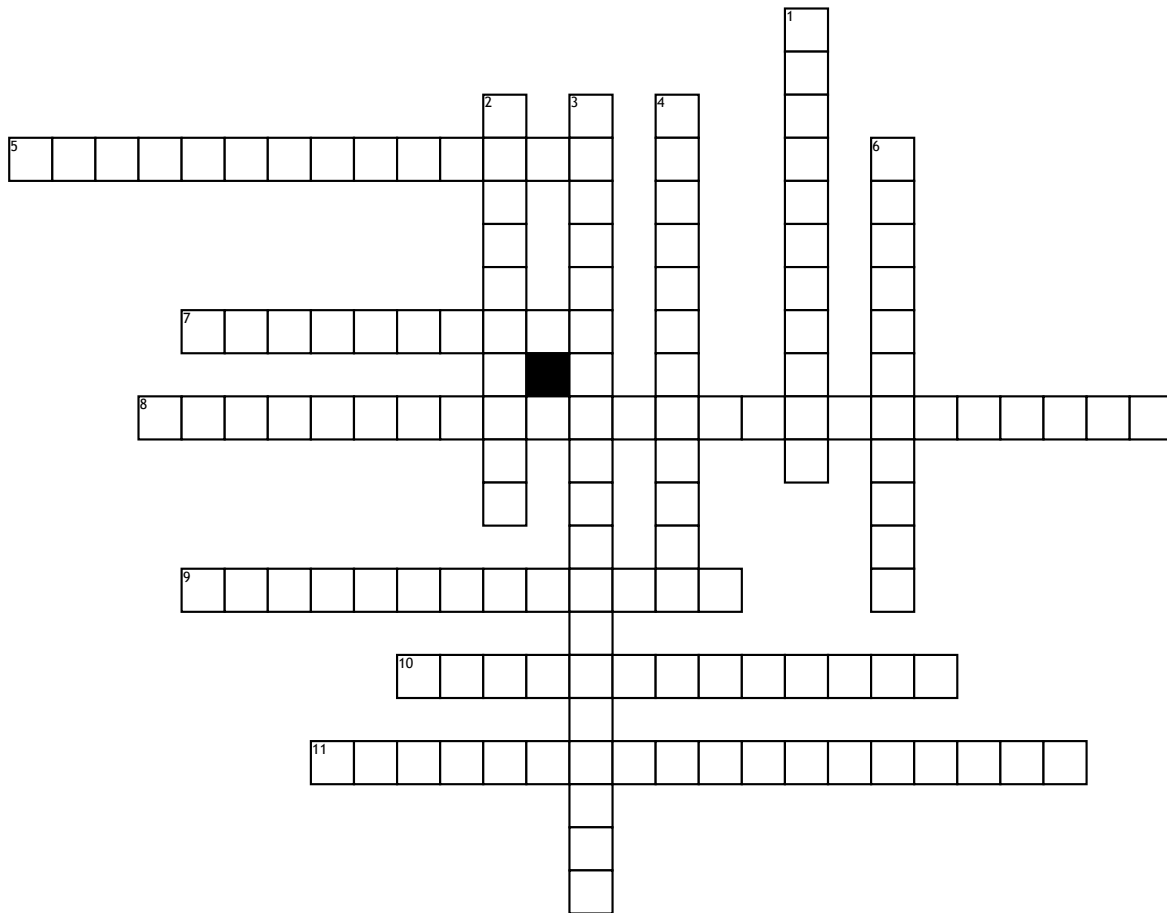

1. The confederate States of America, a confederation formed in 1861 by the Southern states after their secession from the Union.
2. Bombardment near Charleston, South Carolina by the Confederate States Army, and the return gunfire and subsequent surrender by the United States Army that started the American Civil War.
3. "Conductors" on the routes hid fugitives in secret tunnels and false cupboards, provided them with food and clothing, and escorted or directed them to the next "station".
4. A draft that forced men to serve in the army.
6. Went on to found the American Red Cross after the war.
