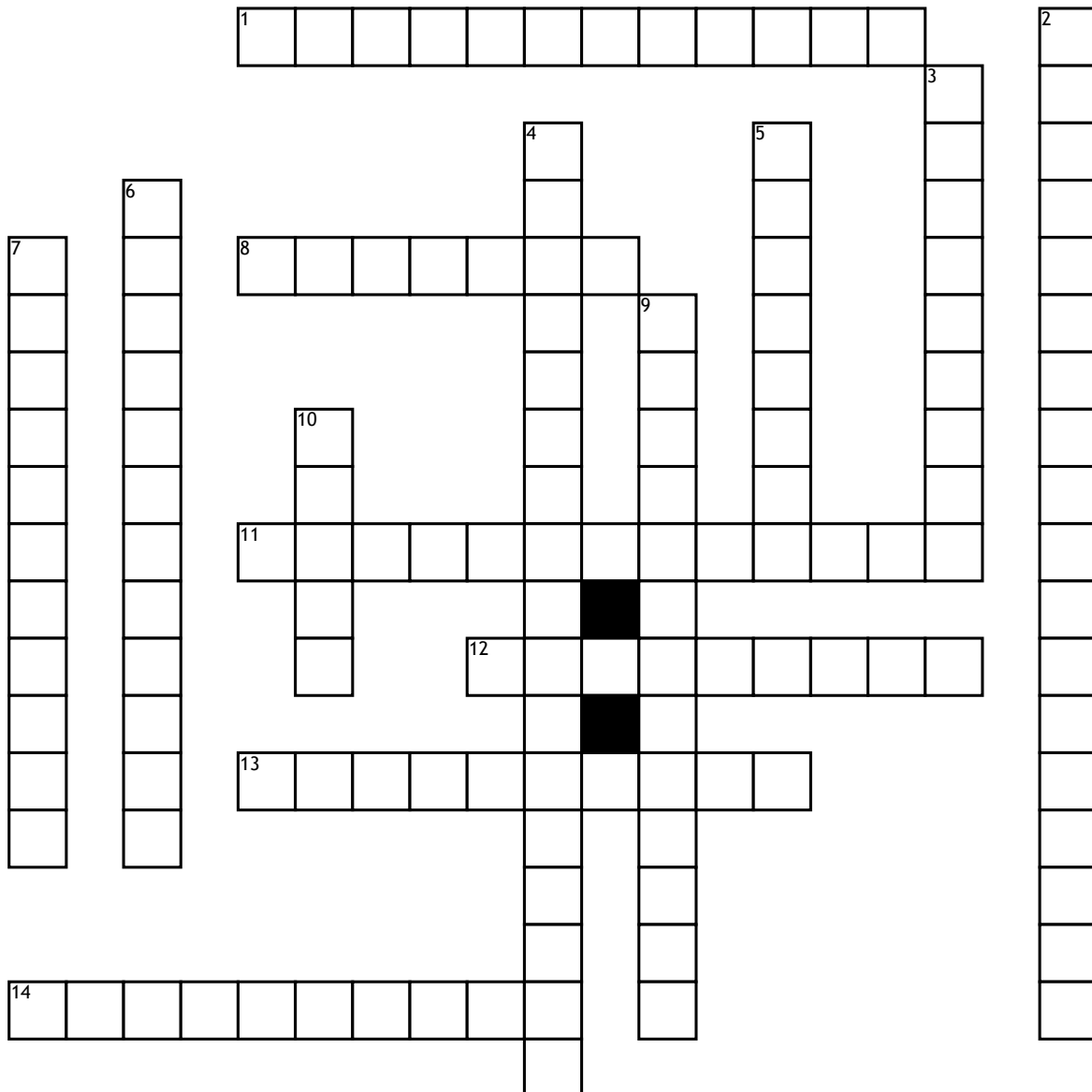

- 13. A body of laws, statutes, and rules enacted by southern states immediately after the Civil War to regain control over the freed slaves, maintain white supremacy, and ensure the continued supply of cheap labor

- 14. a name given to African Americans who moved from states that were along the Mississippi River to Kansas

- 2. the principle that the authority of a state and its government are created and sustained by the consent of its people, through their elected representatives (rule by the people), who are the source of all political power
- 3. white Southerners who supported Reconstruction policies and efforts after the conclusion of the American Civil War
- 4. a provision in which an old rule continues to apply to some existing situations while a new rule will apply to all future cases
- 5. the execution of a person or persons, by the people of an area without the use of a court trial

- 6. an exaggerated devotion to the interests of a region
- 7. state and local laws that enforced racial segregation in the Southern United States and elsewhere within the United States
- 9. abolished slavery and involuntary servitude, except as punishment for a crime
