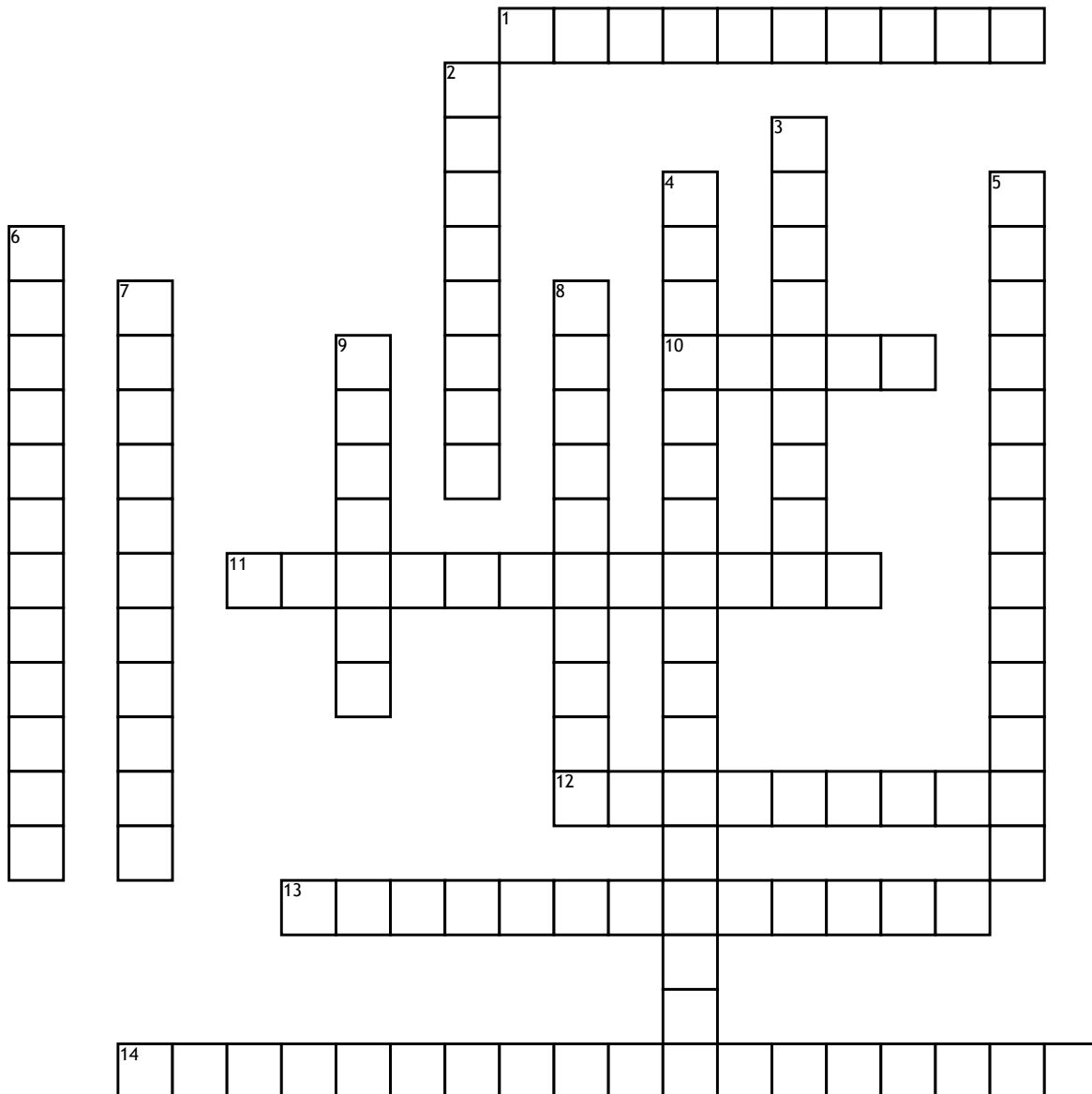


# Civil War and Reconstruction Crossword

12. the action of withdrawing formally from membership of a federation or body, especially a political state.

13. a political candidate who seeks election in an area where they have no local connections.

14. a controversial political doctrine according to which the people of federal territories should decide for themselves whether their territories would enter the Union as free or slave states.

2. kill (someone), especially by hanging, for an alleged offense with or without a legal trial.

3. a person who behaves badly but in an amusingly mischievous rather than harmful way; a rascal.

4. a clause exempting certain classes of people or things from the requirements of a piece of legislation affecting their previous rights, privileges, or practices.

5. Neither slavery nor involuntary servitude, except as a punishment for crime whereof the party shall have been duly convicted, shall exist within the United States, or any place subject to their jurisdiction.

6. restriction of interest to a narrow sphere; undue concern with local interests or petty distinctions at the expense of general well-being.

7. were state and local laws that enforced racial segregation in the Southern United States and elsewhere within the United States.

8. sometimes called Black Laws, were laws governing the conduct of African Americans.

9. a tax levied on every adult, without reference to income or resources.
