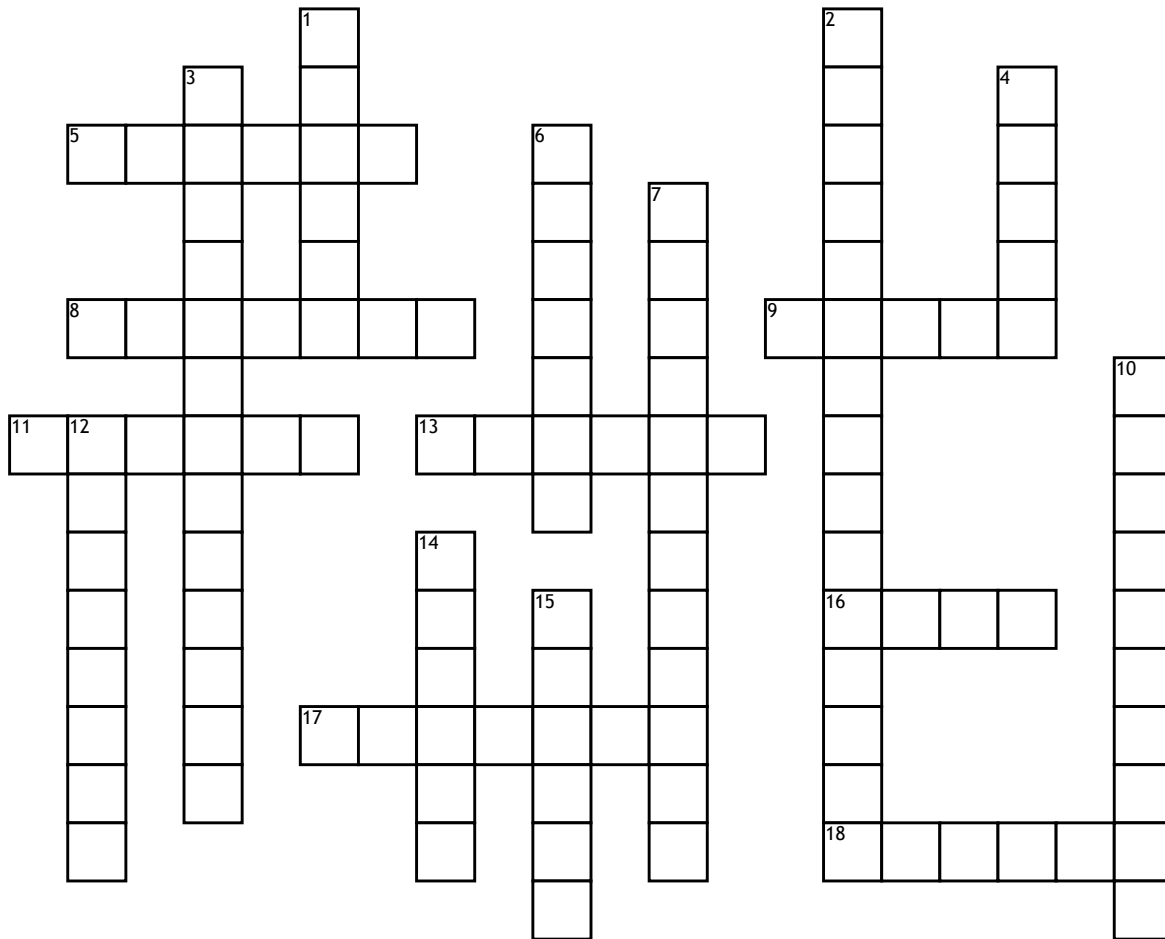


Climate Changes

 2. a wind from the direction that is predominant at a particular place or season.
 3. rain, snow, sleet, or hail that falls to the ground.
 4. moisture condensed from the atmosphere that falls visibly in separate drops.

7. the degree or intensity of heat present in a substance or object

10. the envelope of gases surrounding the earth or another planet.

12. a geographic coordinate that specifies the north-south position of a point on the Earth's surface
