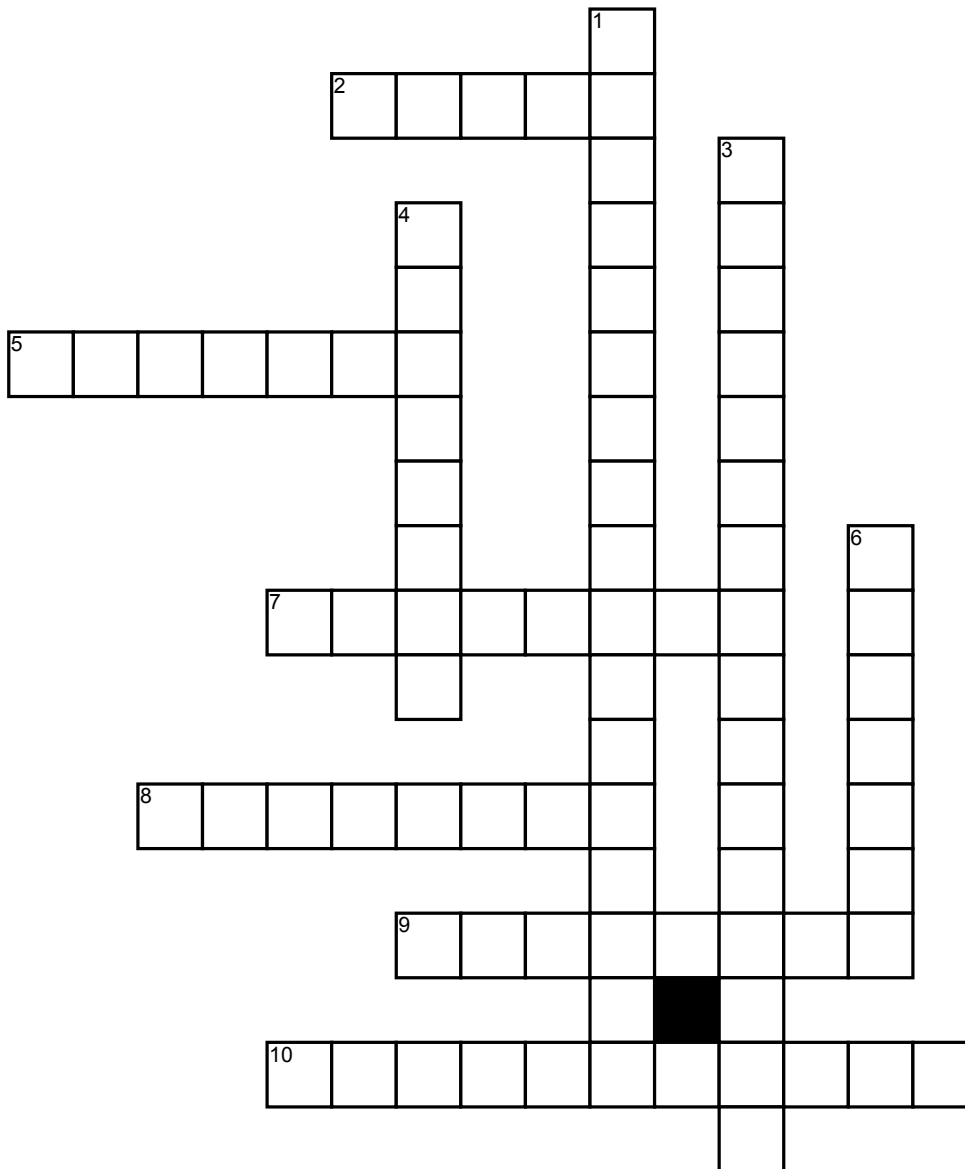

8. A cold, northward flowing ocean current that can be found in the southeast Atlantic Ocean.
