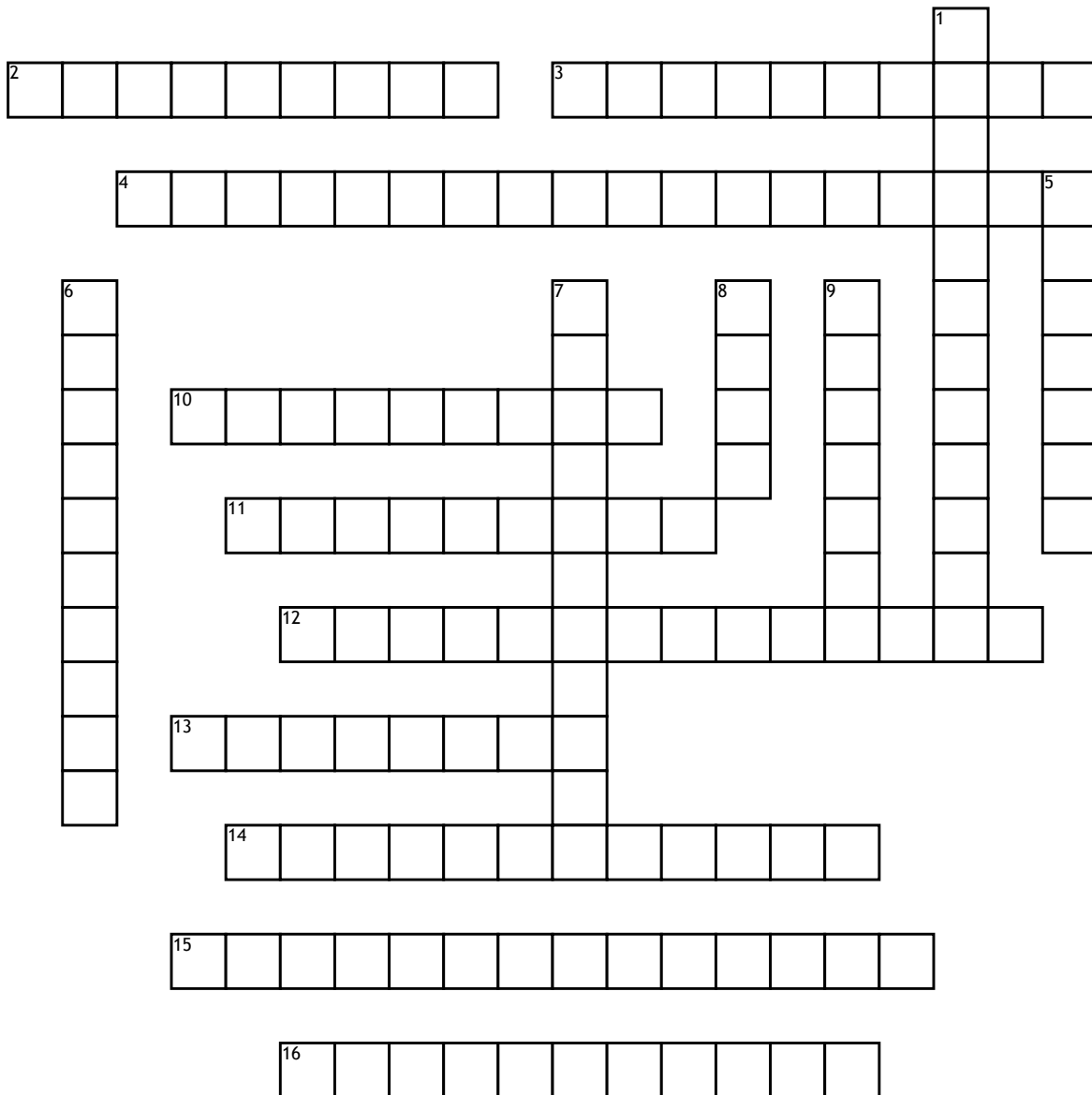

- 4. an international crisis in October 1962, the closest approach to nuclear war at any time between the US and the Soviet Union.
- 10. (1890-1969), Vietnamese communist statesman; president of North Vietnam 1954-69; born Nguyen That Thanh.
- 11. the competition between nations regarding achievements in the field of space exploration.

12. the principle that the US should give support to countries or peoples threatened by Soviet forces or communist insurrection.

13. a competition between nations for superiority in the development and accumulation of weapons, especially between the US and the former Soviet Union during the Cold War.

14. the theory that a political event in one country will cause similar events in neighboring countries

15. a covert system of trails along Vietnam's western frontier.

16. the notional barrier separating the former Soviet bloc and the West prior to the decline of communism that followed the political events in eastern Europe in 1989.

1. a program of financial aid and other initiatives, sponsored by the US

5. each of a series of Soviet artificial satellites, the first of which (launched on October 4, 1957) was the first satellite to be placed in orbit.

8. North Atlantic Treaty Organization, an international organization composed of the US, Canada, Britain, and a number of European countries
