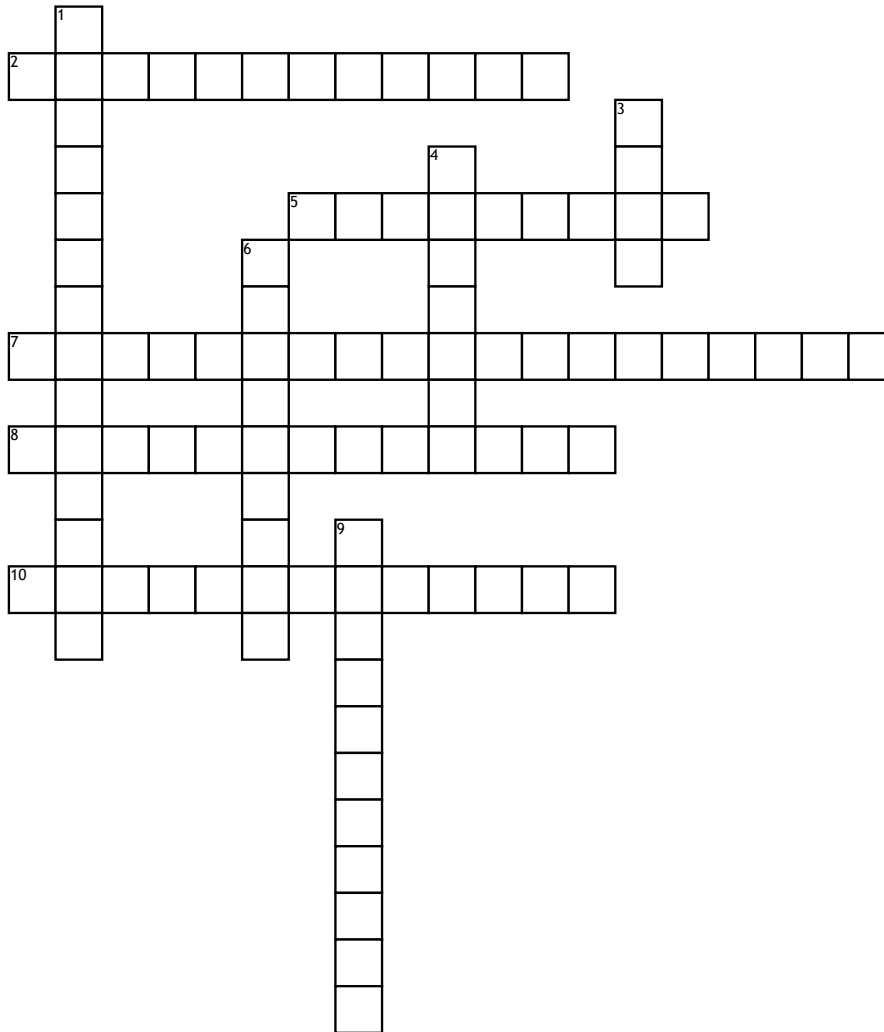

- 8. Tests of nuclear weapons, which were prohibited except for those conducted underground went into effect on Oct. 10, 1963.
- 10. A conference from April 26 to July 21 1954 that focused primarily on resolving the war between french forces and the democratic republic of Vietnam.
