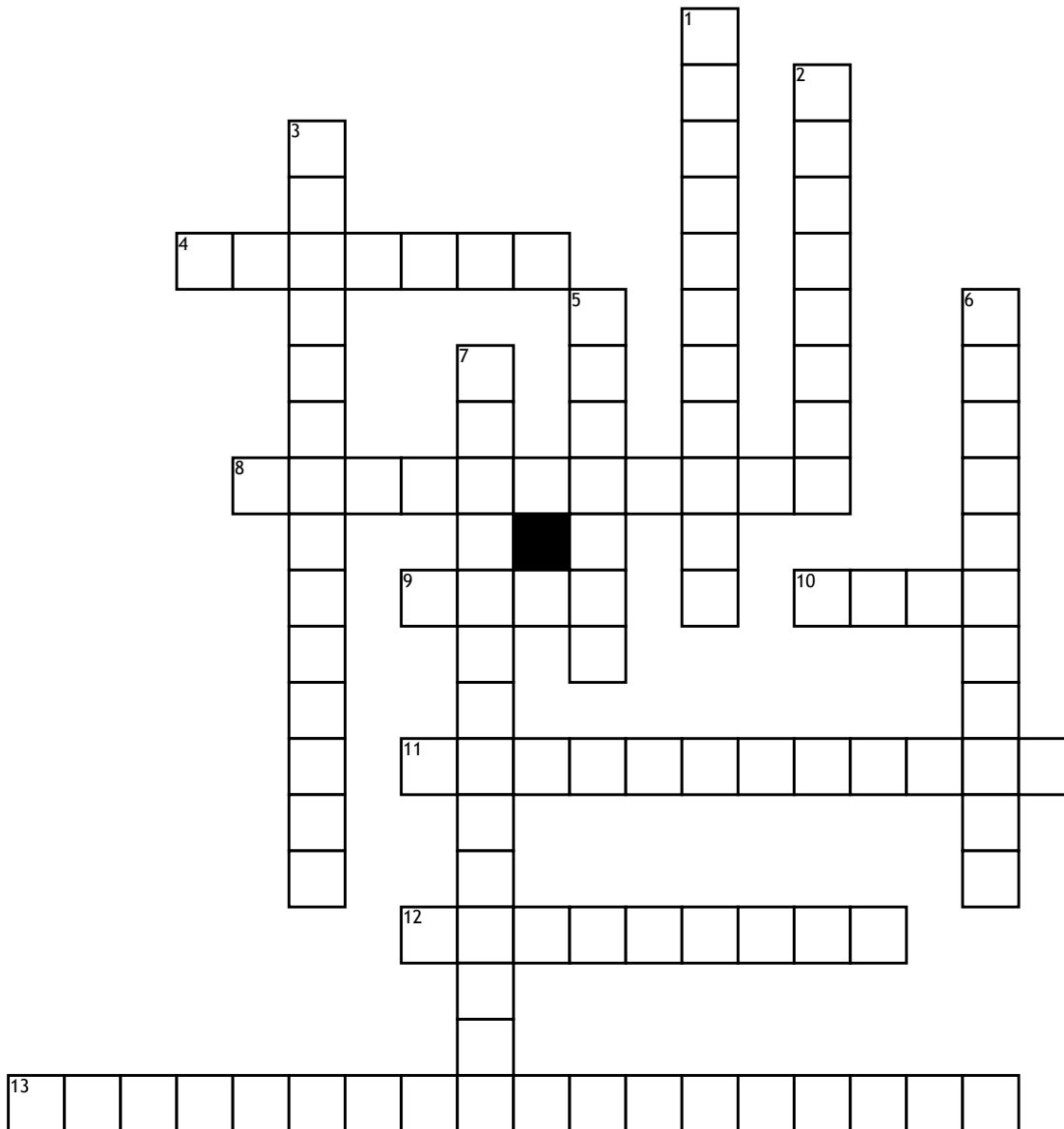


# Cold War Domestic Policies
