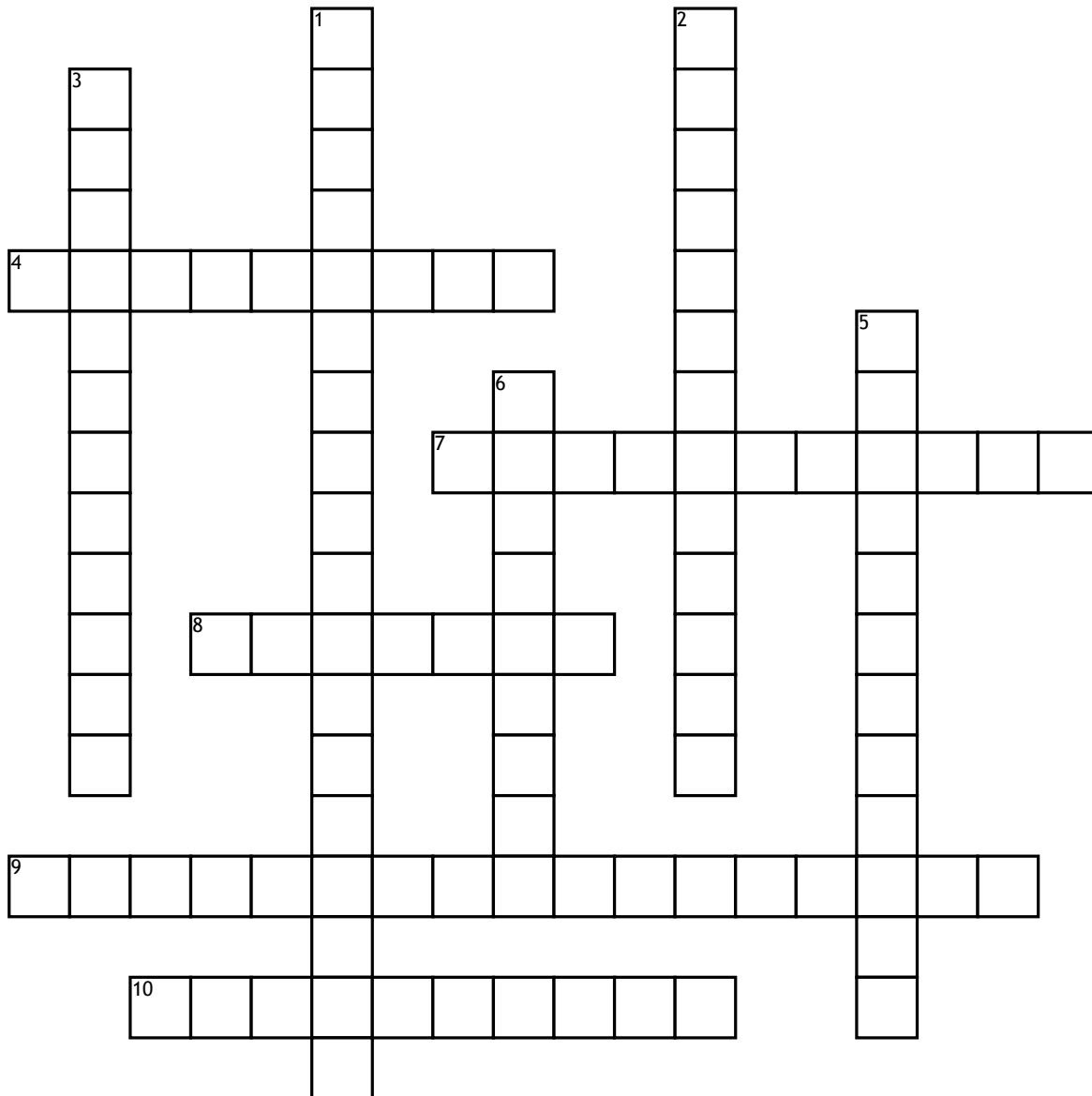

9. splits the Korean peninsula in half creating a buffer zone between North Korea and South Korea, and it is the most fortified border in the world
10. a economic system with private ownership of goods, prices, production, and distribution of goods that are determined by competition in the free market

1. a confrontation between the US and Soviet Union in 1962 over the presence of missile sites in Cuba
2. a international organization, with headquarters in NYC, formed to promote international peace, signed by 51 founding countries in 1945
3. turning point of the Vietnam War

6. a war between North Korea (supported by China and Soviet Union) and South Korea (supported by the US) from 1950-1953
