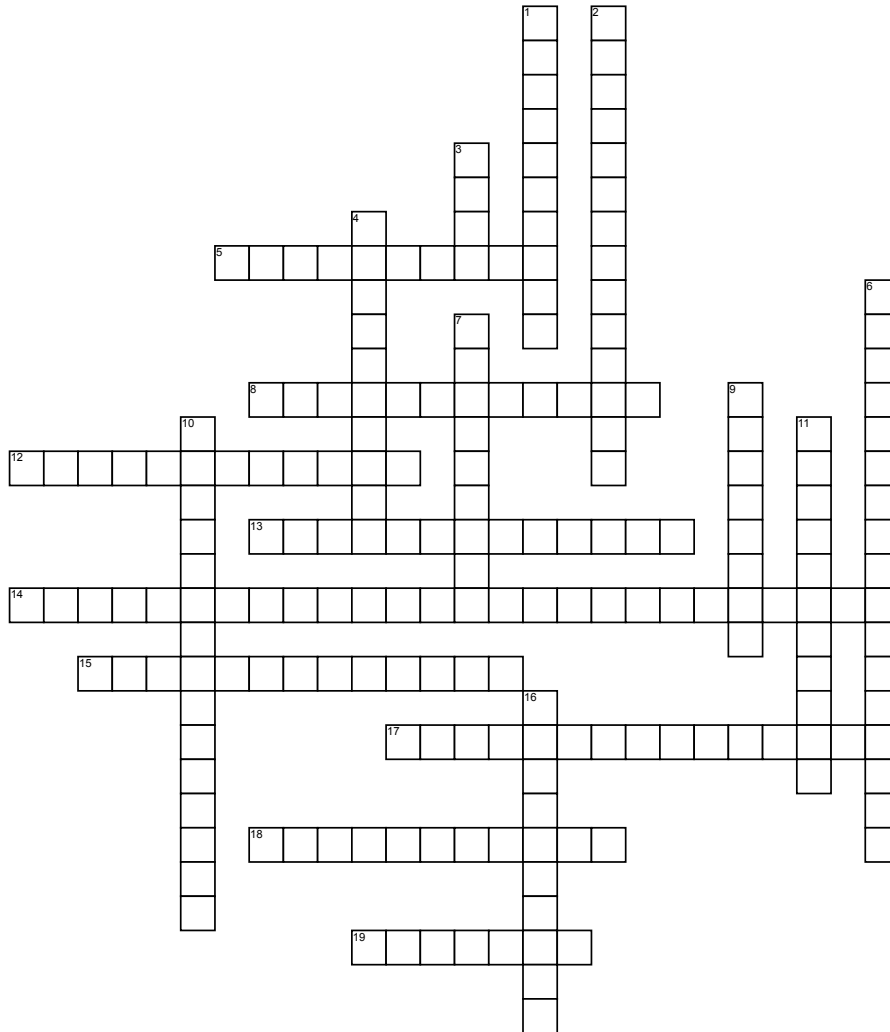

- 12. A program by which the United States gave large amounts of economic aid to European countries to help them rebuild after World War II.
- 13. A military operation in the late 1940s that brought food and other needed goods into West Berlin
- 14. a doctrine of military strategy and national security policy in which a full-scale use of nuclear weapons
- 15. is an international organization formed in 1945 to increase political and economic cooperation.

- 1. occurred during the Cold War on 1 May 1960, during the presidency of Dwight D. Eisenhower
 - 2. the principle that the US should give support to countries or peoples threatened by Soviet forces or communist insurrection.
 - 3. a military alliance of European and North American democracies founded after World War II

- 4. Fortified concrete and wire barrier that separated East and West Berlin
- 6. where Roosevelt, Stalin, and Churchill drew up plans for the administration of Germany and Poland after World War II ended.

- 10. was first used to describe certain nations in the Cold War.
- 11. the action of keeping something harmful under control or within limits.
