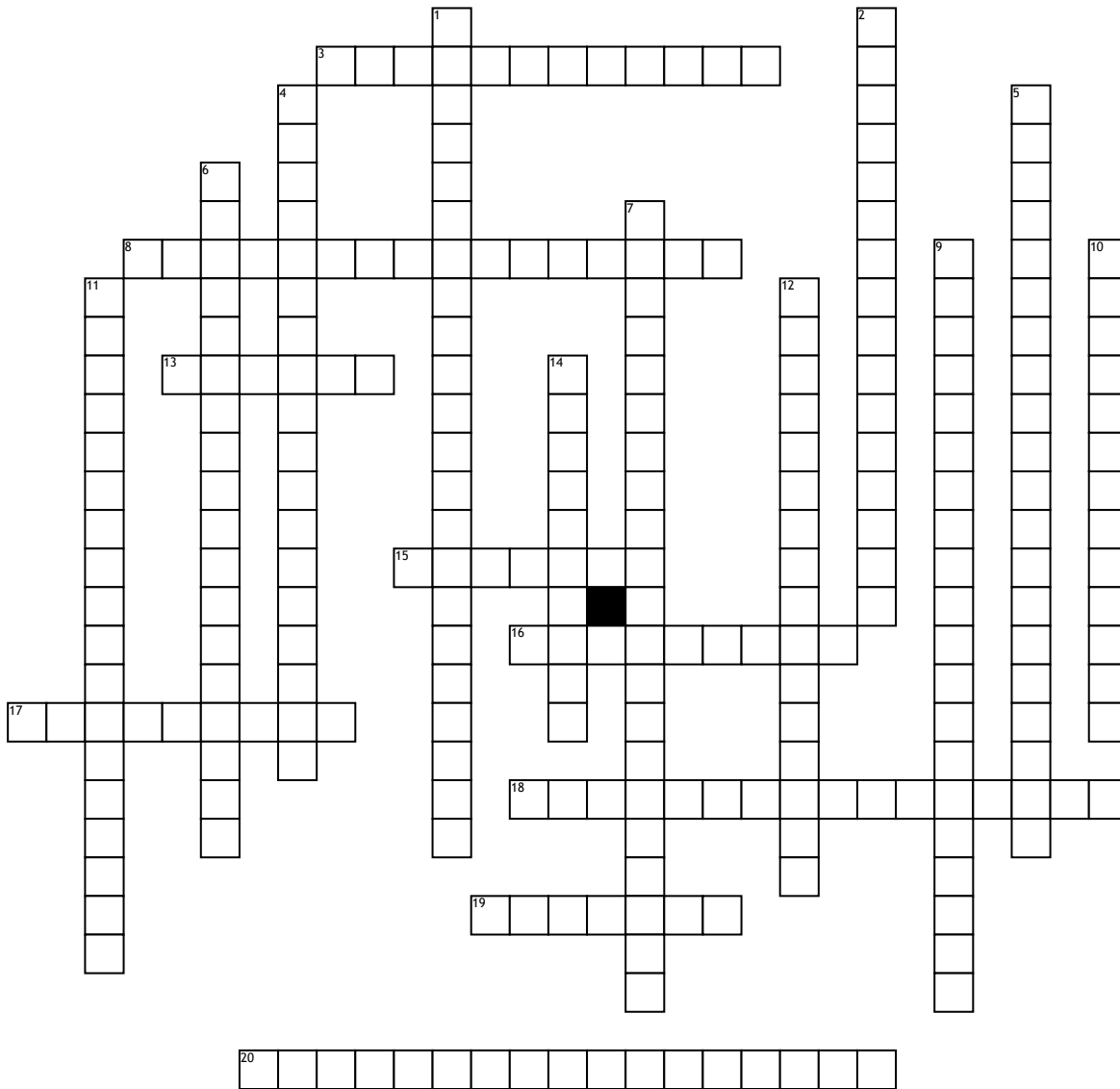

 1. People enter into groups with different attitudes and perspectives that they bring into the group
 2. Structural Conduciveness, Level of structural Strain, Generalized belief, Mobilization for action and Action of Social Control
 4. the action of behavior of people in groups or crowds - usually as a reaction to an event or to express a common sentiment

5. Social conditions and the resources that are available for making that change occur
 6. Individuals sense of connection with a larger community or group
 7. Shared emotional bond that makes people act on their animalist emotions
