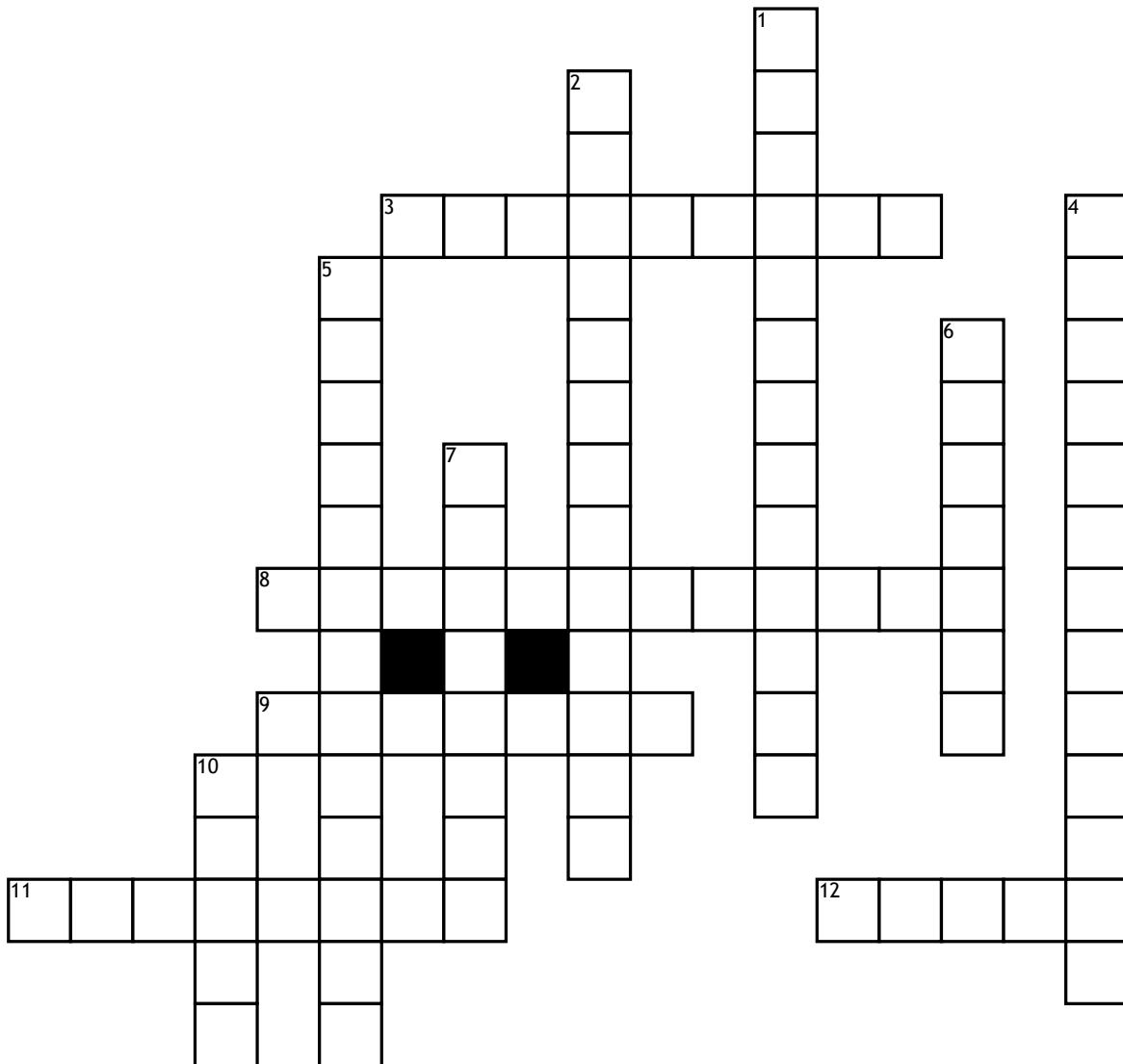


Color and Texture Crossword
