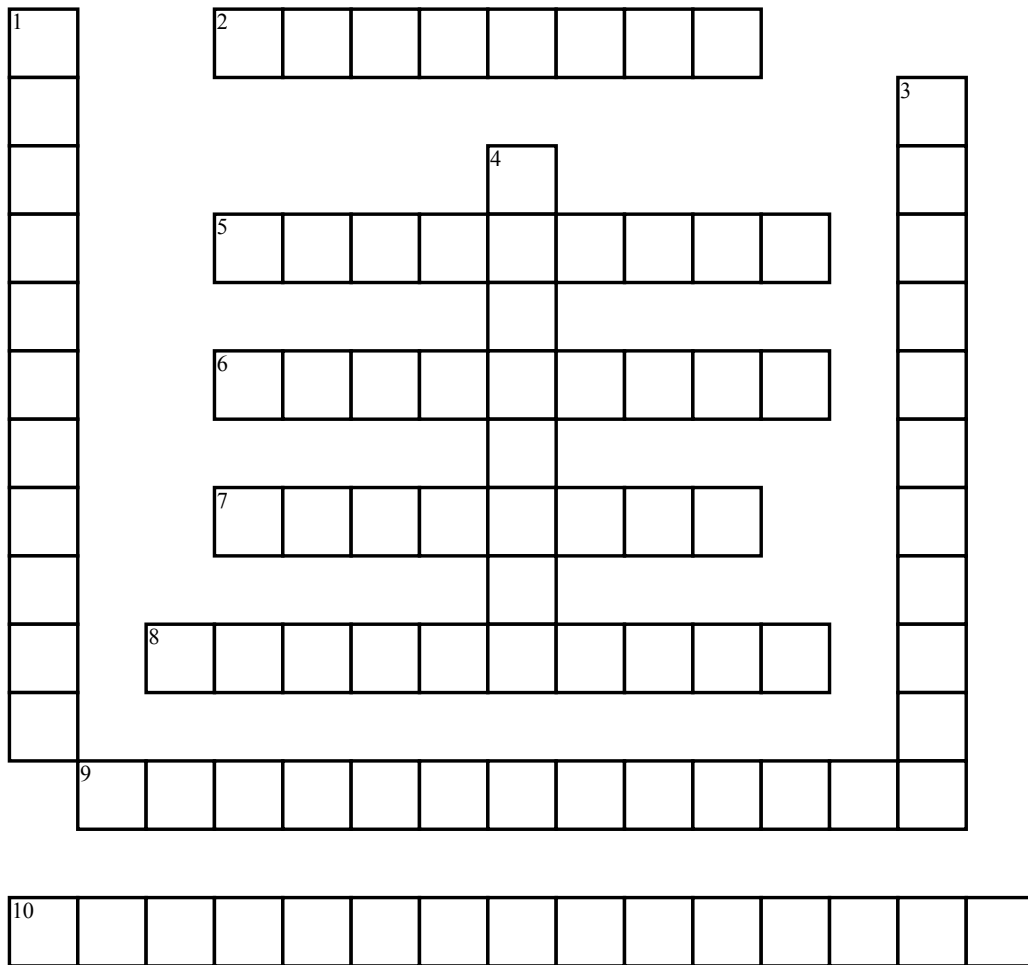


Comfort, Rest, and Sleep Key terms
