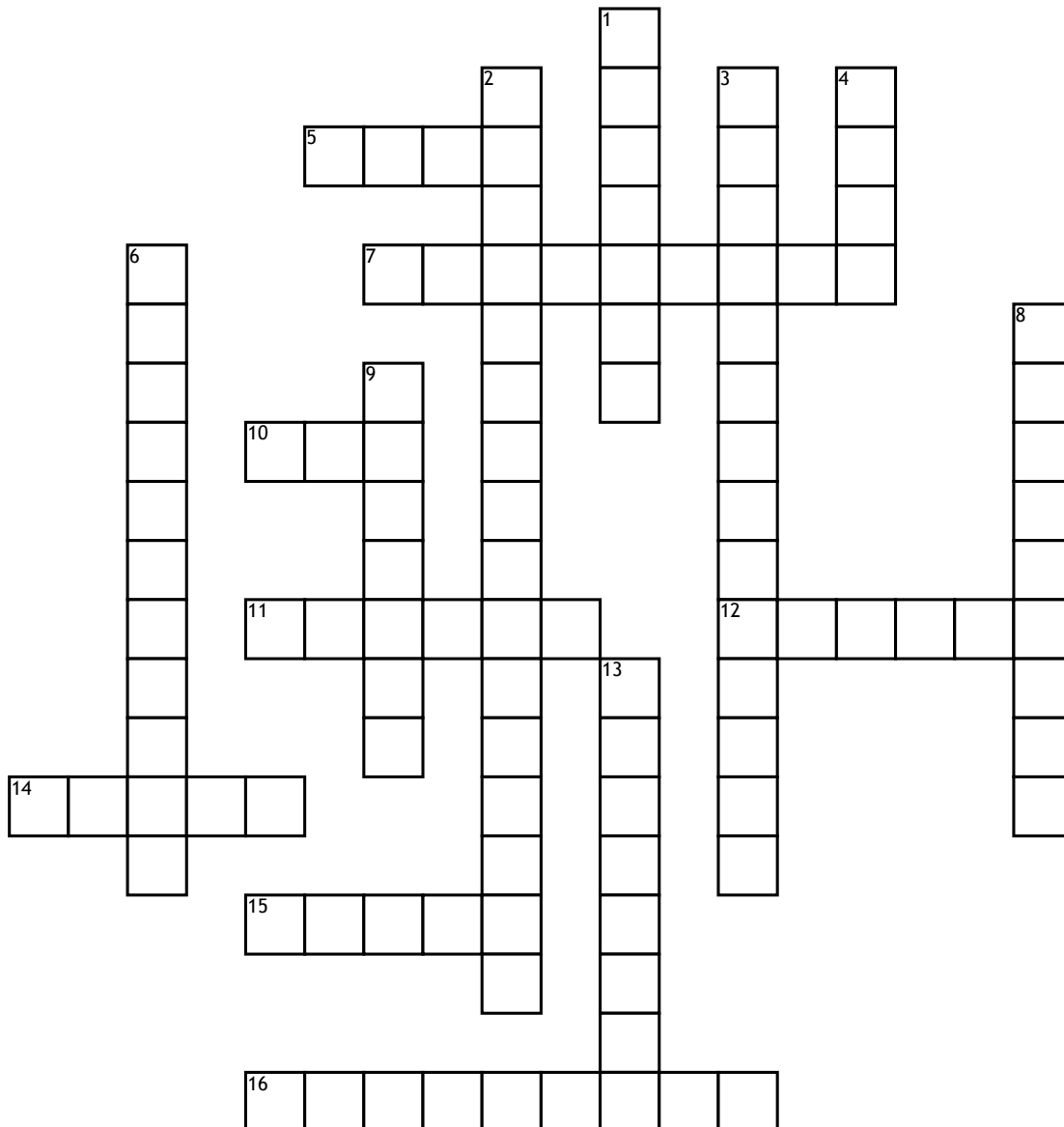


Competency Cross Word Fun
