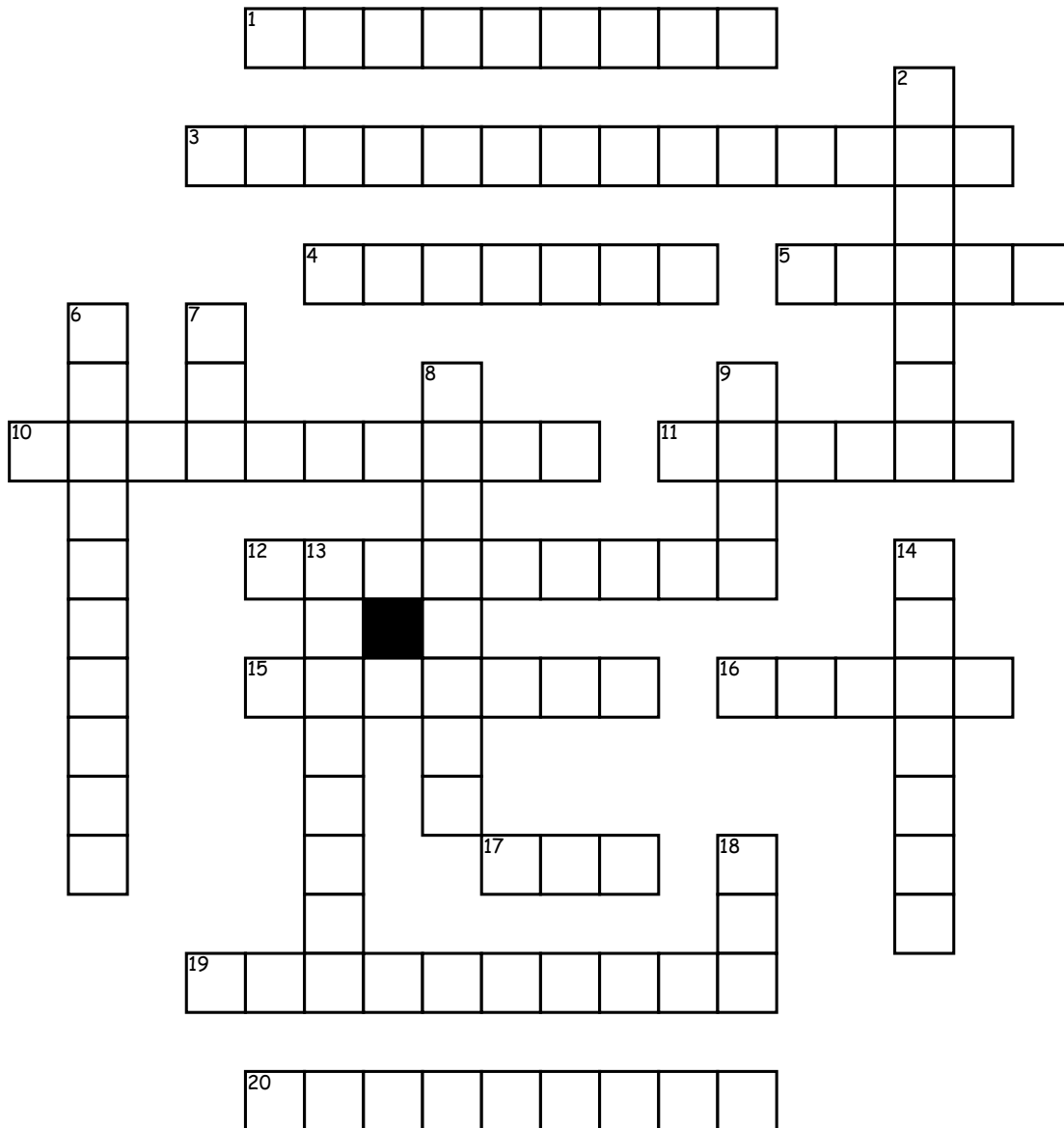


Competency Terminology
