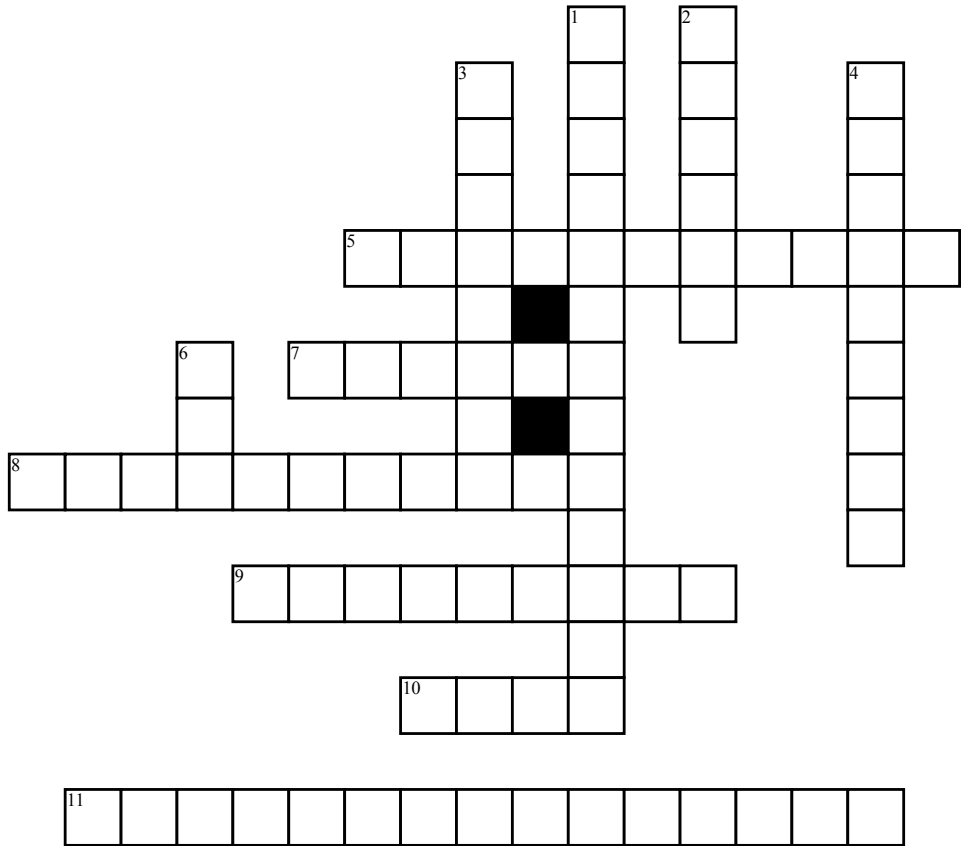

- 1. Hardware, software, or both, that allow a user to interact with and perform operations on a system, program, or other device.
- 2. The rules that govern the structure of language statements; in particular, the rules for forming statements in a source language correctly.

- 3. A program that translates a program into machine code that can be converted into an executable program (an object program).
- 4. An ordered set of well-defined instructions for the solution of a problem in a finite number of steps.
- 6. Binary digit. The smallest unit of information for data storage and transmission. Each bit is considered to be either a "0" or a "1".
