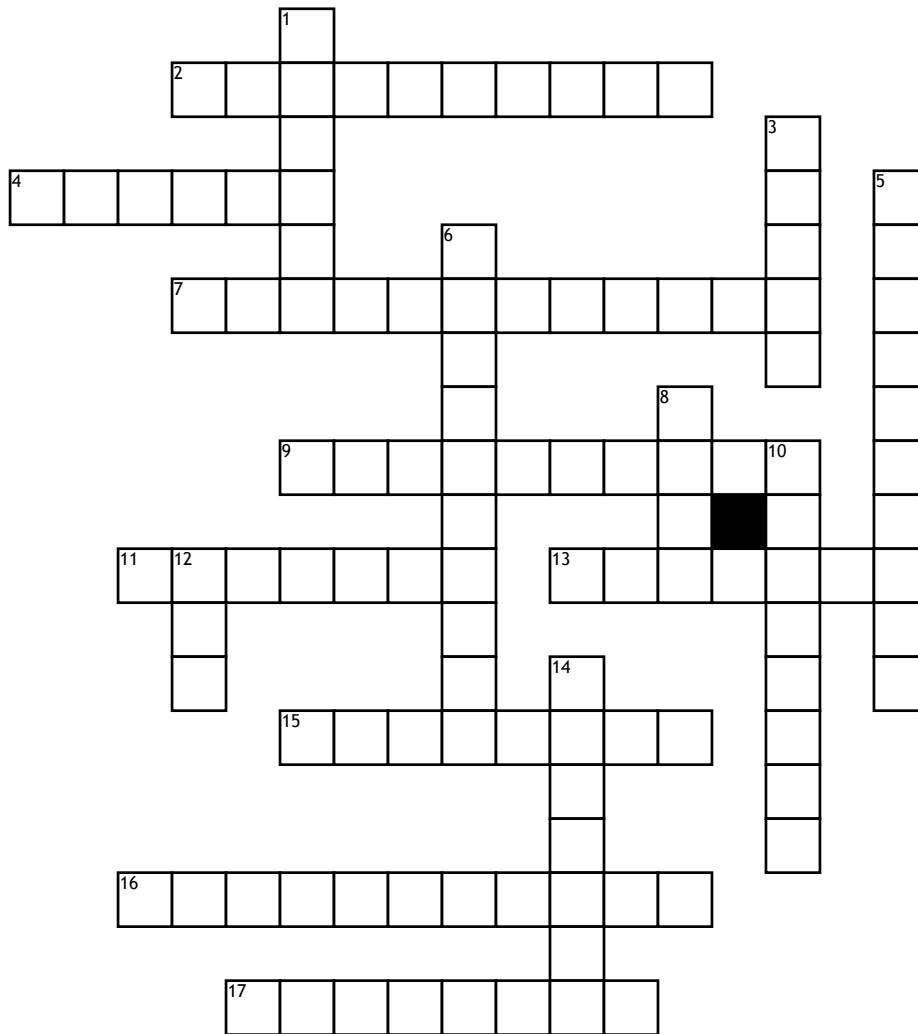


Computer System Components

2. A mobile phone that performs many of the functions of a computer, typically having a touchscreen interface, Internet access, and an operating system capable of running downloaded applications.
4. A small portable computer that accepts input directly onto its screen rather than via a keyboard or mouse.
7. A piece of computer hardware equipment used to provide data and control signals to an information processing system such as a computer or information appliance.
9. A device that can send or receive pictures and text over a telephone line.
11. A device that scans documents and converts them into digital data.
13. An output device that prints paper documents.

15. A battery- or AC-powered personal computer generally smaller than a briefcase that can easily be transported and conveniently used in temporary spaces such as on airplanes, in libraries, temporary offices, and at meetings.

16. A computer system with more than one display connected.

17. An input device used to enter letters, numbers, and other symbols into a computer.

1. A portable computer, usually battery-powered, small enough to rest on the user's lap and having a screen that closes over the keyboard like a lid.
3. An input device that is most often used with a personal computer; moved along a flat surface can move the on-screen cursor to different items on the screen.

5. An internal or external device that connects directly to a computer but does not contribute to the computer's primary function, such as computing.

6. Place on a computer where a compact disc can be held, read and played.

8. A facility allowing computers, smartphones, or other devices to connect to the Internet or communicate with one another wirelessly within a particular area.

10. Any type of storage device that is connected to and controlled by a computer but is not integrated within it.

12. The primary component of a computer that processes instructions.

14. A display screen used to provide visual output from a computer, cable box, video camera, VCR or other video generating device.
