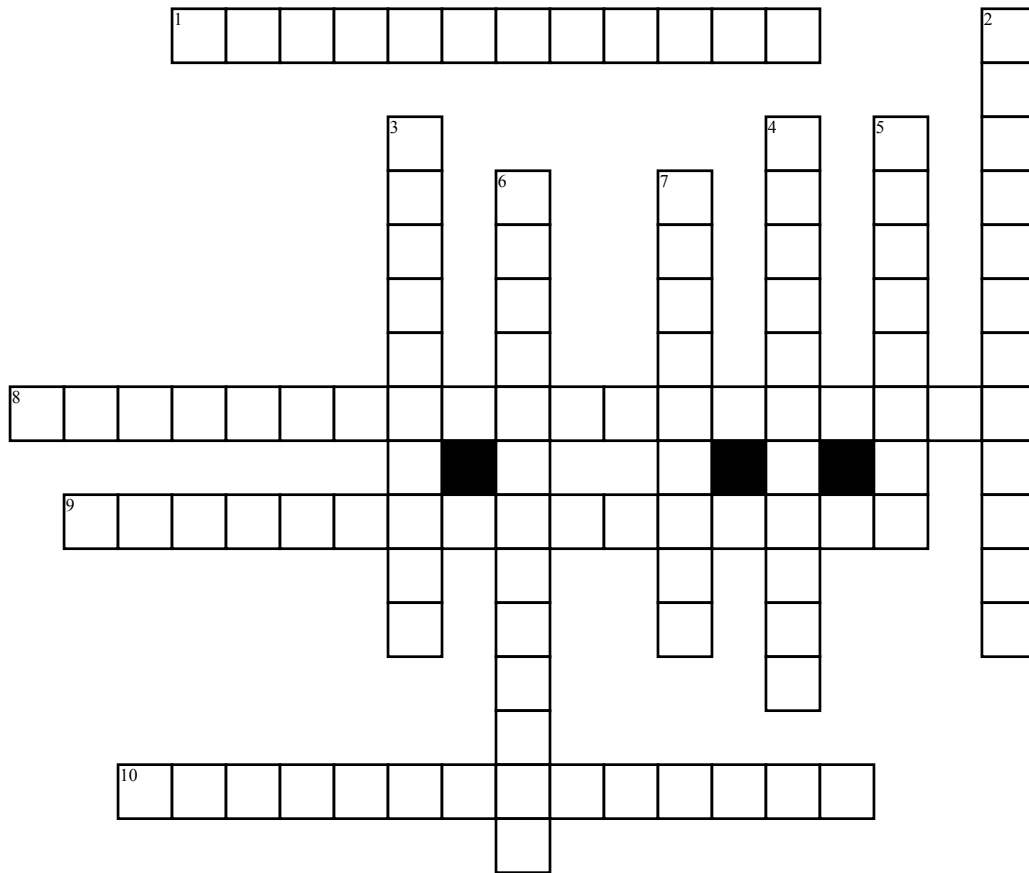


# Consciousness

- 1. splitting off of mental process into two separate streams of awareness
- 8. view consciousness as a product of cultural influence having little to do with the individual
- 9. makes thoughts, feelings, sensations feel alert
- 10. hat divided consciousness is a common, normal experience

## Down

- 2. state in which there is a shift in the pattern of mental activity

- 3. The responsivity shown by some blind or partially blind people to visual stimuli of which they are not consciously aware
- 4. The inability of a person to recognize his or her own illness or handicap
- 5. the induction of a state of consciousness in which a person apparently loses the power of voluntary action
- 6. a state of awareness, including feelings, sensations, ideas and perceptions
- 7. claimed that consciousness, and therefore personal identity, are independent of all substances
