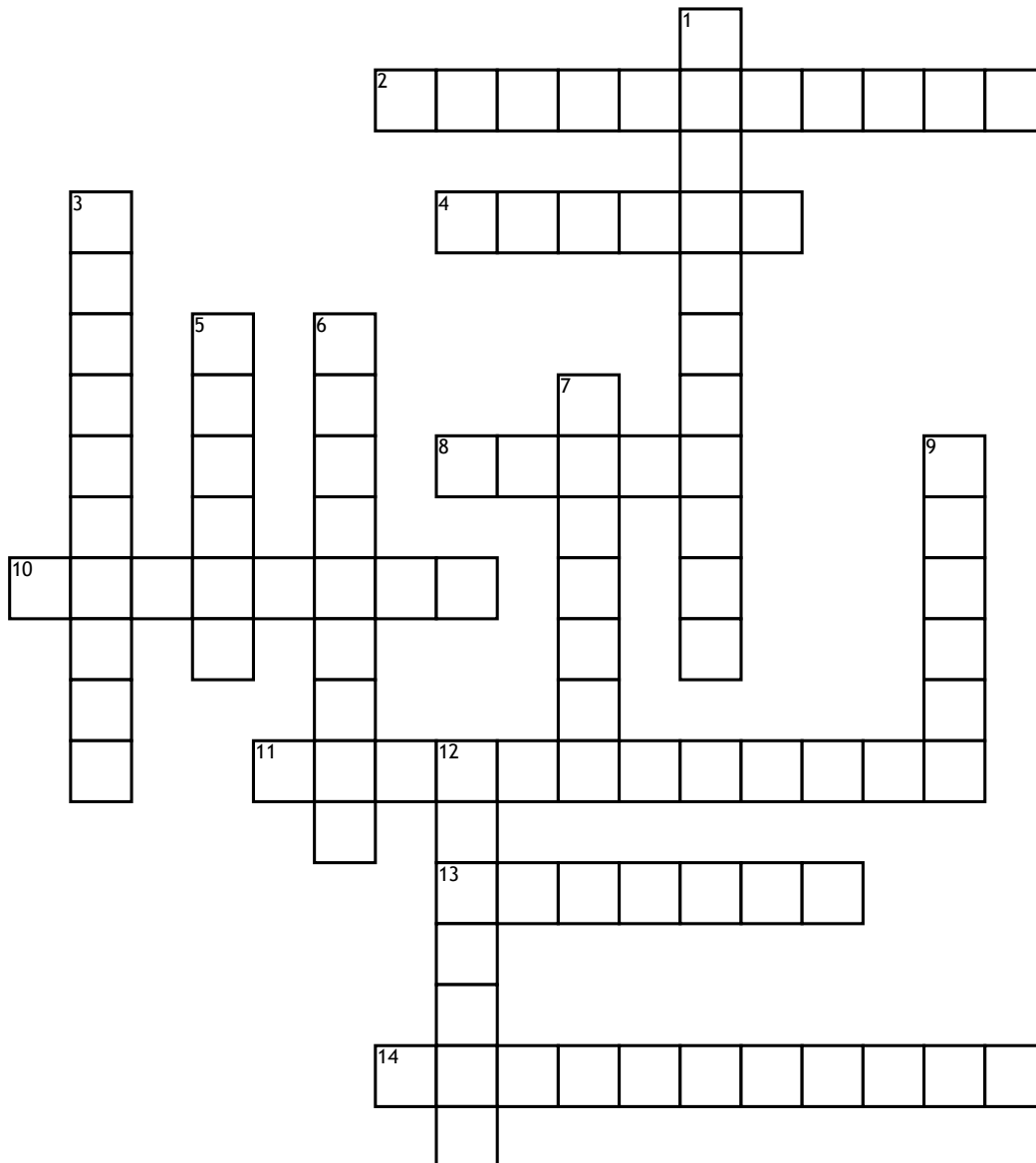


# Consonant Sounds
