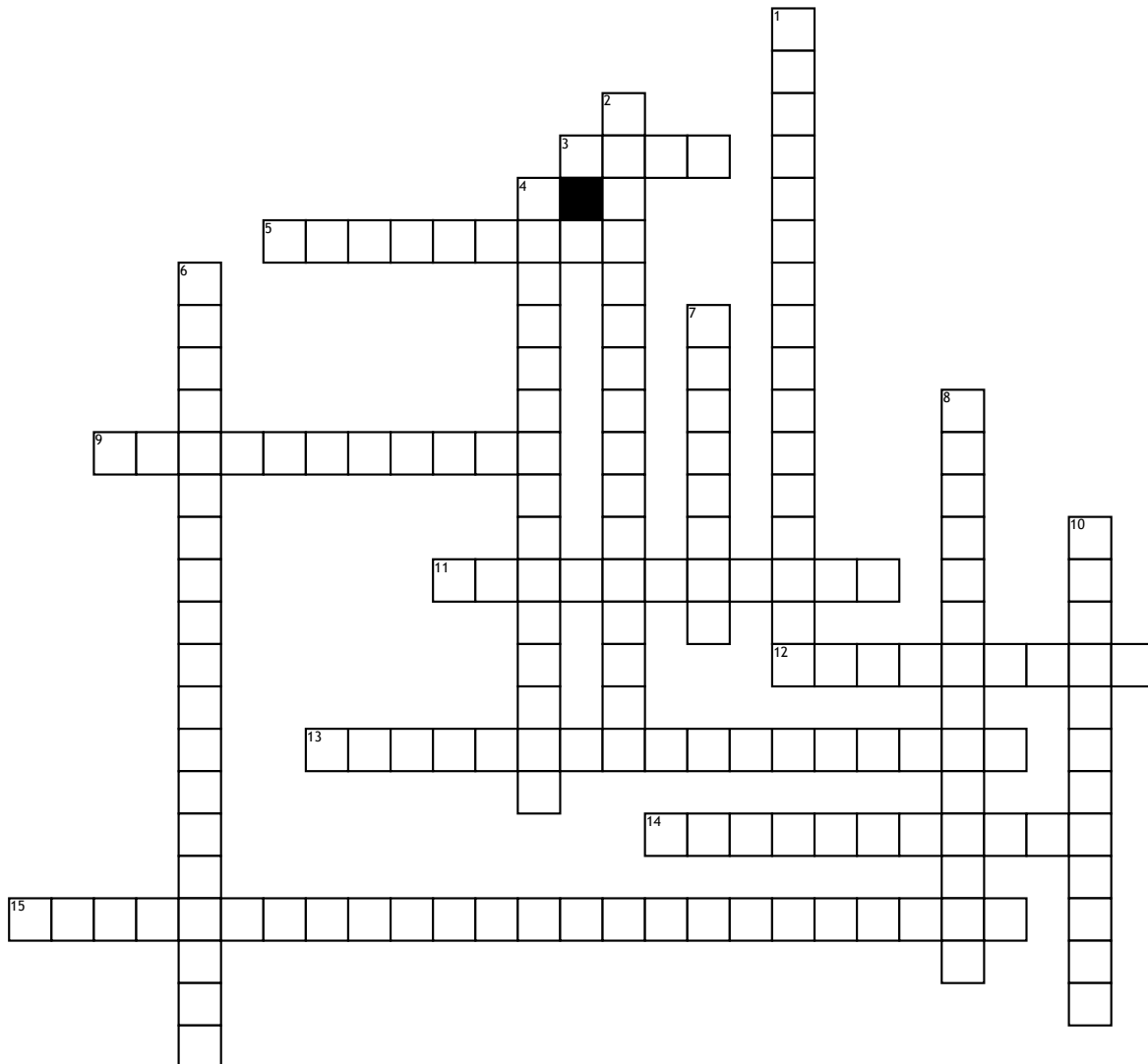

# Constitutional Convention



## Across

- 3. Number of states that sent representatives to the Annapolis Convention
- 5. Having two branches or chambers
- 9. Laws that make an act illegal after it was committed
- 11. This compromise would count 3/5 of the slave population for taxation and representation purposes
- 12. This plan called for equal representation
- 13. System that makes sure not one branch becomes too powerful

- 14. Only state that did not attend the Constitutional Convention
- 15. Took place from May to September 1787 to fix the issues in the Articles of Confederation

## Down

- 1. Presided over the Constitutional Convention
- 2. Introduced the New Jersey Plan
- 4. Compromise between the two plans; representation in the lower house based on population and upper house would be represented by two delegates from each state

- 6. Meeting in 1786 to address interstate trade issues with the Articles of Confederation; first attempt to address the issues with the Articles
- 7. This plan called for representation based on population
- 8. Daniel Shays led a rebellion of farmers in MA seeking debt relief from the state legislature through paper money; showed the weakness of the Articles of Confederation and that a new form of government needed to be created
- 10. Introduced the Virginia Plan
