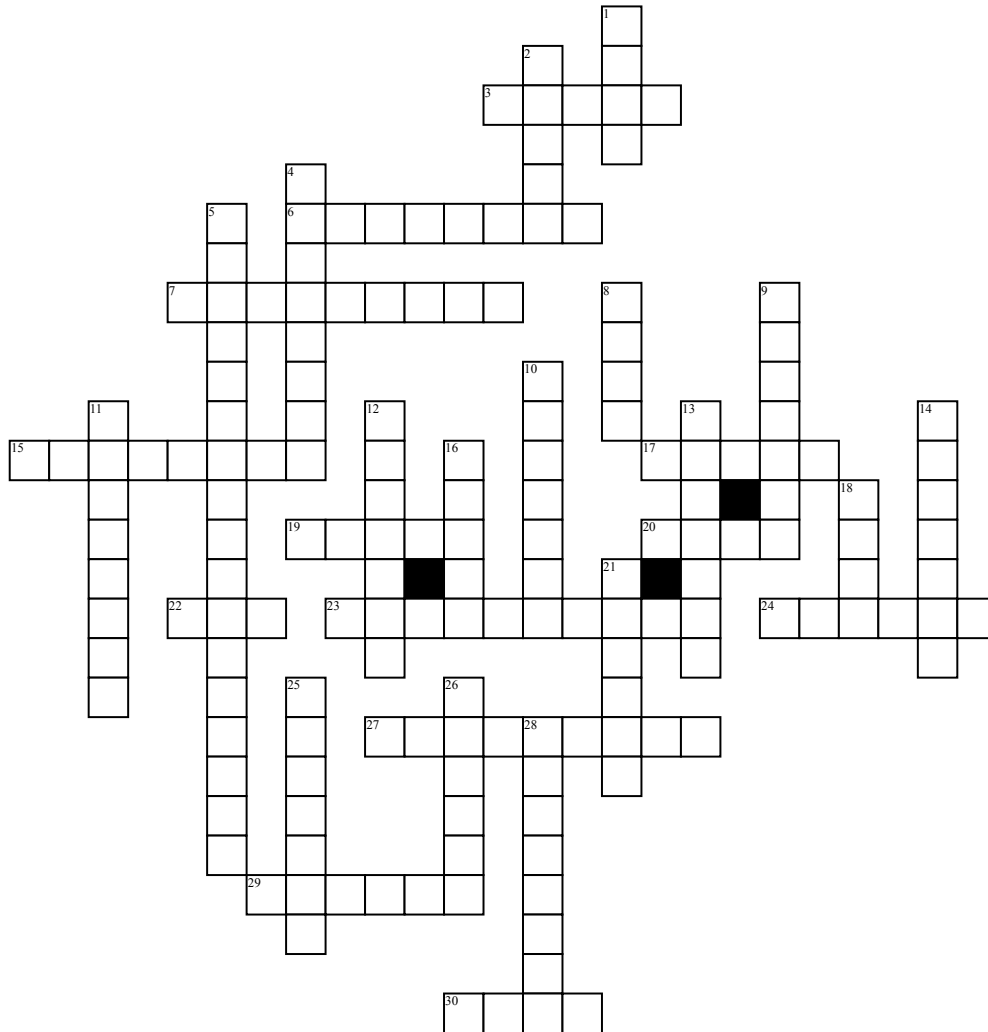


Constitutional Crossword Puzzle

- 6. a group of people gathered together in one place for a common purpose.
- 7. a system of government by the whole population or all the eligible members of a state.
- 15. relating to or characteristic of soldiers or armed forces.
- 17. relating to ordinary citizens and their concerns, as distinct from military or ecclesiastical matters. "civil aviation"
- 19. modify formally, as a legal document or legislative bill.
- 20. a person's first appearance or performance in a particular capacity or role.
- 22. the system of rules that a particular country or community recognizes as regulating the actions of its members and may enforce by the imposition of penalties.
- 23. the governing body of a nation, state, or community.
- 24. a process of voting, in writing and typically in secret.
- 27. an article added to the US Constitution.
